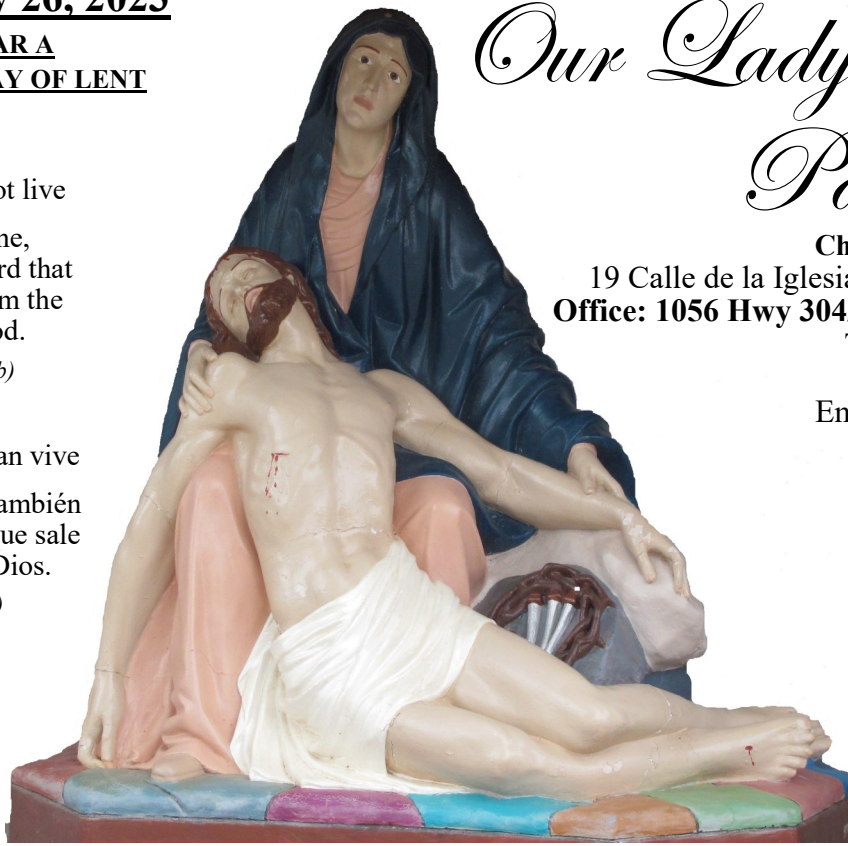

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT PRIMER DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

FOCUS: Through Christ we are made righteous and have eternal life.

On this first Sunday of Lent, our readings bring into focus the great drama of our salvation history: Our first parents sinned, and through them death came to all. Yet our gracious God sent his Son not to condemn but to free us and show his power over Satan. Through him we are made righteous.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, the serpent convinces the woman to eat fruit from the forbidden tree, which she shares with her husband. Their eyes are opened and they realize they are naked. In the second reading Paul writes that, through the obedience of Christ, many will become righteous. In the Gospel, Jesus is tempted by Satan after fasting for 40 days and 40 nights. Jesus resists all that Satan offers and commands him to get away.

ENFOQUE: Por medio de Cristo somos hechos justos y tenemos vida eterna.

En este primer domingo de Cuaresma, nuestras lecturas enfocan el gran drama de nuestra historia de salvación: Nuestros primeros padres pecaron y, a través de ellos, la muerte llegó a todos. Sin embargo, nuestro Dios misericordioso envió a su Hijo, no para condenarnos, sino para liberarnos y mostrar su poder sobre Satanás. Por Él somos hechos justos.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, la serpiente convence a la mujer para que coma del fruto del árbol prohibido, que comparte con su marido. Sus ojos se abren y se dan cuenta de que están desnudos. En la segunda lectura, Pablo escribe que, por la obediencia de Cristo, muchos llegarán a ser justos. En el Evangelio, Jesús es tentado por Satanás después de un ayuno de 40 días y 40 noches. Jesús resiste todo lo que Satanás le ofrece y le ordena: *Retirate*.

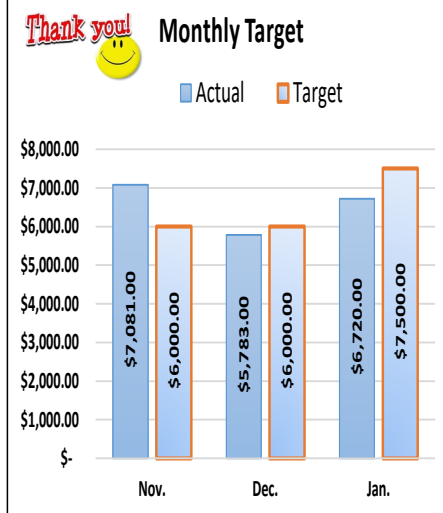
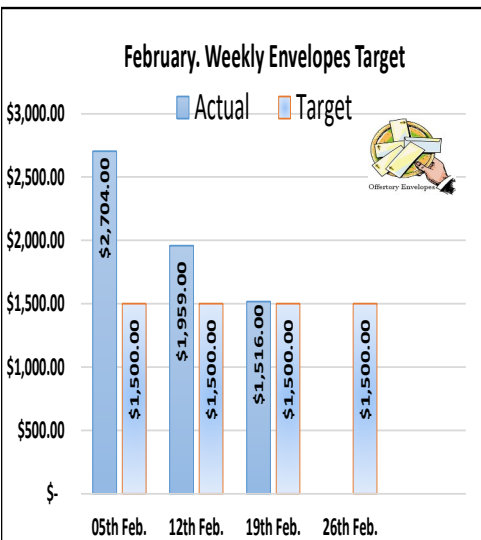

Statement to the Faithful of the Archdiocese of Santa Fe:

My dear Brothers and Sisters,

As we begin this holy season of Lent, we give thanks to God for this time of reflection and prayer when we can prepare to renew our baptismal promises and celebrate the great solemnity of Easter.

Part of our preparation involves engaging in penitential practices, namely, prayer, fasting, and works of charity. To this end, the Bishops of the United States have preserved in our dioceses the tradition of abstinence from meat on each of the Fridays of Lent, "confident that no Catholic Christian will lightly hold himself excused from this penitential practice" (National Conference of Catholic Bishops, Statement, November 18, 1966, n. 13). The law of abstinence binds those Catholics who have completed the fourteenth year of their age (can. 1252).

From time to time, certain feasts occur during the Lenten season that suggest a more festive celebration (USCCB Statement, n. 16). This year, the Memorial of Saint Patrick falls on Friday, March 17. It is well known that Saint Patrick's Day is a day of convivial celebration for many American Catholics.

I, therefore, decree that on Friday, March 17, 2023, all Catholics of the Archdiocese of Santa Fe, New Mexico, no matter where they may be, and all other Catholics present in the Archdiocese on that day, are, by my authority, dispensed from the obligation (can. 87 §1). It is not required that anyone make use of this dispensation. Those who do wish to make use of it are encouraged to abstain from meat on some other day as part of their penitential practices during Lent.
