PENTECOST SUNDAY DOMINGO DE PENTECOSTÉS

FOCUS: Today is Pentecost, the birthday of the Church, honoring the coming of the Spirit into our midst.

The early Church was expanded when the resurrected Jesus left his disciples, promising to send the Holy Spirit to be with them on earth. Empowered by his presence among them, they began preaching the word even though they faced many challenges. The people listened and were baptized, and the Church was born.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, the Apostles are filled with the Holy Spirit and begin speaking in different languages. Paul writes to the Corinthians that there is only one Spirit, but he bestows many spiritual gifts on the family of God. In the Gospel, Jesus comes to the disciples in the locked room, offers them peace, and breathes on them, saying, receive the Holy Spirit.



ENFOQUE: Hoy es Pentecostés, el cumpleaños de la Iglesia, honrando la venida del Espíritu en medio de nosotros.

La Iglesia primitiva se expandió cuando Jesús resucitado dejó a sus discípulos, prometiendo enviar al Espíritu Santo para estar con ellos en la tierra. Empoderados por su presencia entre ellos, comenzaron a predicar la palabra, a pesar de que enfrentaron muchos desafíos. El pueblo escuchó y se bautizó, es así que nació la Iglesia.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, los Apóstoles están llenos del Espíritu Santo y comienzan a hablar en diferentes idiomas. Pablo escribe a los Corintios que hay un solo Espíritu, pero otorga muchos dones espirituales a la familia de Dios. En el Evangelio, Jesús se acerca a los discípulos en la habitación cerrada, les ofrece la paz y sopla sobre ellos, diciendo, reciban el Espíritu Santo.

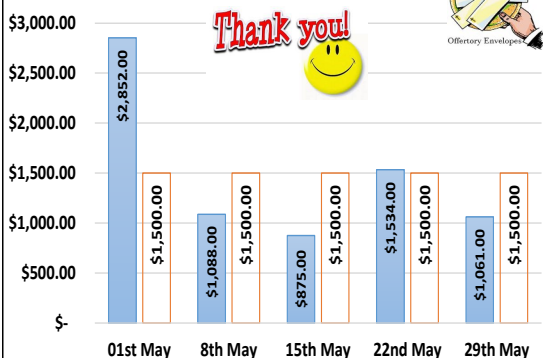

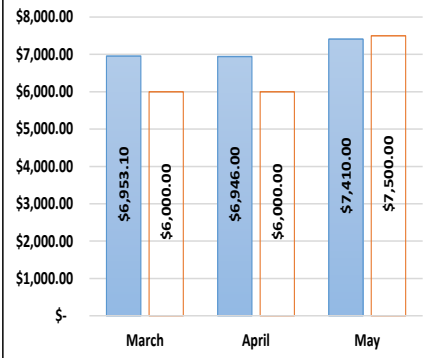
