The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, historically known by its Latin name, Corpus Christi, celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. It is traditionally celebrated on the Thursday following the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity. The feast dates to the Middle Ages and originated with a visionary nun and a Eucharistic miracle.

### THE STORY

In 1263 a German priest, Fr. Peter of Prague, made a pilgrimage to Rome. He stopped in Bolsena, Italy, to celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Christina. At the time he was having doubts about Jesus being truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. He was affected by the growing debate among certain theologians who, for the first time in the history of the Church, began introducing doubts about the Body and Blood of Christ being actually present in the consecrated bread and wine. In response to his doubt, when he recited the prayer of consecration as he celebrated the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, blood started seeping from the consecrated host and onto the altar and corporal.

Fr. Peter reported this miracle to Pope Urban IV, who at the time was nearby in Orvieto. The pope sent delegates to investigate and ordered that host and blood-stained corporal be brought to Orvieto. The relics were then placed in the Cathedral of Orvieto, where they remain today.

This Eucharistic Miracle confirmed the visions given to St. Juliana of Mont Cornillon in Belgium (1193-1258). St. Juliana was a nun and mystic who had a series of visions in which she was instructed by Our Lord to work to establish a liturgical feast for the Holy Eucharist, to which she had a great devotion.

After many years of trying, she finally convinced the bishop, the future Pope Urban IV, to create this special feast in honor of the Blessed Sacrament, where none had existed before. Soon after her death, Pope Urban instituted Corpus Christi for the Universal Church and celebrated it for the first time in Orvieto in 1264, a year after the Eucharistic Miracle in Bolsena.

Inspired by the miracle, Pope Urban commissioned a Dominican friar, St. Thomas Aquinas, to compose the Mass and Office for the feast of Corpus Christi. Aquinas' hymns in honor of the Holy Eucharist, *Pange Lingua*, *Tantum Ergo*, *Panis Angelicus*, and *O Salutaris Hostia* are the beloved hymns the Church sings on the feast of Corpus Christi as well as throughout the year during Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

**THE MOST HOLY BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)  
SANTISIMO CUERPO Y SANGRE DE CRISTO (CORPUS CHRISTI)**

**FOCUS:** Here in the great mystery of the Eucharist, Christ fulfills his promise to be with his people always.

Today we profess and acknowledge the Eucharist as the source and summit of our faith. Here, under the appearance of bread and wine, Christ's body and blood are broken and shared, and we celebrate Christ's enduring presence with us. Here we encounter his compassionate love and healing, and here we are strengthened and nourished to live the Gospel.

**LITURGY OF THE WORD**

In the first reading, Melchizedek – a priest of God Most High – brings bread and wine to Abram and blesses him. Paul writes to the Corinthians, telling them what he received from the Lord: that the Lord offered his body and blood to his disciples. Paul says, as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes. In the Gospel, Jesus speaks to the crowds about God's kingdom and heals all who need healing. He then feeds them (about five thousand in number), using five loaves and two fish.



**ENFOQUE:** Aquí, en el gran misterio de la Eucaristía, Cristo cumple su promesa de estar siempre con su pueblo.

Hoy no solo profesamos, sino que también reconocemos a la Eucaristía como fuente y cumbre de nuestra fe. Aquí, bajo la apariencia de pan y vino, el cuerpo y sangre de Cristo se parten y comparten; asimismo, celebramos la presencia perdurable de Cristo con nosotros. Aquí encontramos su amor tanto compasivo como sanador; además, aquí somos fortalecidos y nutridos para vivir el Evangelio.

**LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA**

En la primera lectura, Melquisedec -sacerdote de Dios, el Altísimo- trae pan y vino a Abram y lo bendice. Pablo escribe a los Corintios, diciéndoles lo que recibió del Señor: que el Señor ofreció su cuerpo y su sangre a sus discípulos. Pablo dice que siempre que coman este pan y beban esta copa, proclamarán la muerte del Señor hasta que él vuelva. En el Evangelio, Jesús habla a la multitud sobre el reino de Dios y sana a todos los que necesitan sanación. Luego los alimenta (alrededor de cinco mil), usando cinco panes y dos peces.

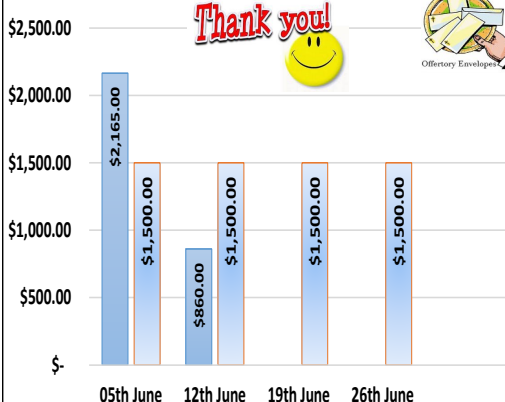

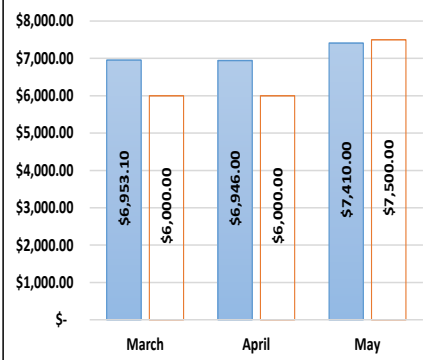
