**TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
VIGÉSIMO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO**

FOCUS: Persevere in running the race.

Faithful disciples of the Lord Jesus will face opposition for living the truth and values of God's kingdom. When confronted, we must keep our eyes fixed on Jesus and persevere in running the race.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Jeremiah is thrown into a cistern and left to die. He is then rescued by a court official. The author of the Letter to the Hebrews encourages the community to persevere in running the race, keeping their eyes fixed on Jesus, who himself faced persecution. In the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples that he has come not to bring peace but division.

ENFOQUE: Perseverar en correr la carrera.

Los fieles discípulos del Señor Jesús enfrentarán a la oposición por vivir la verdad y valores del reino de Dios. Cuando nos enfrentamos, debemos mantener nuestros ojos fijos en Jesús y perseverar en correr la carrera.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, Jeremías es arrojado a una cisterna y dejado a morir. Luego es rescatado por un funcionario de la corte. El autor de la Carta a los Hebreos anima a la comunidad a perseverar en la carrera, manteniendo los ojos fijos en Jesús, que enfrentó la persecución. En el Evangelio, Jesús les dice a sus discípulos que no ha venido a traer paz, sino división.

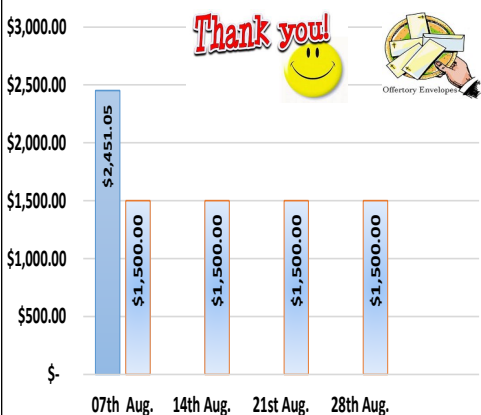

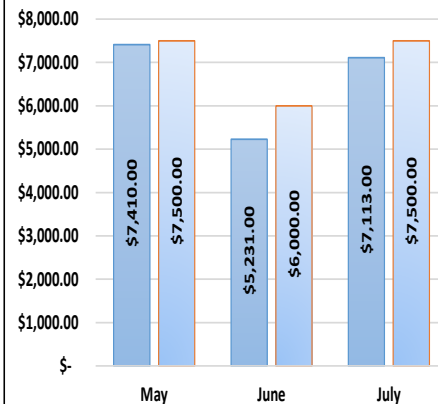
