## TWENTY– NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**FOCUS:** Christ came to give his life as a ransom for many.

As Jesus reveals that he is the Suffering Servant who must suffer and die, so we, his disciples, can expect to follow him along the road to Calvary. Yet even in light of this painful truth, we have a marvelous hope: the hope that the now glorified Suffering Servant will intercede for us before the throne of God.

### LITURGY OF THE WORD

Isaiah prophesies the servant who, through his suffering, will justify many. In the Letter to the Hebrews, Jesus is described as the *great high priest who has passed through the heavens*. In the Gospel, James and John ask Jesus to allow them to sit at his right and left hand in his glory.

**ENFOQUE:** El discipulado requiere valentía.

En la segunda lectura, escribe el autor, *la palabra de Dios es viva y eficaz, más penetrante que espada de doble filo*. En el Evangelio, Jesús tiene un intercambio con un joven de muchas posesiones, que le pregunta qué debe hacer *para heredar la vida eterna*.

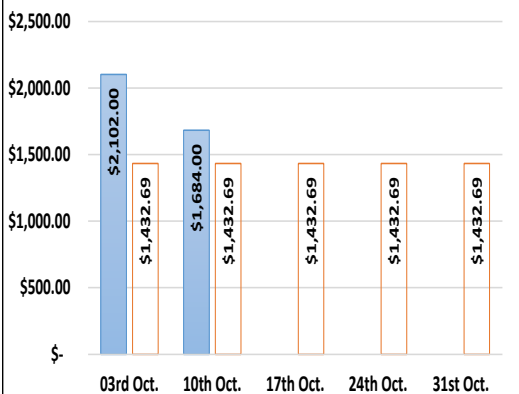

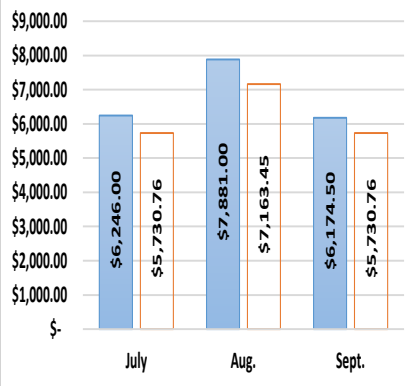
