THIRTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FOCUS: Jesus invites us to follow him and make God's way our own.

As we respond in faith to God's call, our way becomes less our own and more of one united to his love. Jesus invites us to follow him, and when our spiritual blindness interferes with our ability to do so, Jesus heals and redeems us through his compassionate love. Jesus guides his disciples and they support one another.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Jeremiah foretells the return of the remnant of Israel from exile, carefully gathered and guided back by the Lord. In the second reading, Christ is described as a high priest called by God to make an offering for our sins. In the Gospel, Jesus heals the blind beggar Bartimaeus, who then follows Jesus *on the way*.

ENFOQUE: Jesús nos invita a seguirlo y hacer nuestro el camino de Dios.

A medida que respondemos con fe al llamado de Dios, nuestro camino se vuelve menos nuestro y se une a su amor. Jesús nos invita a seguirlo, y cuando nuestra ceguera espiritual interfiere con nuestra capacidad de hacerlo, Jesús nos sana y nos redime a través de su amor compasivo. Jesús guía a sus discípulos y ellos se apoyan unos a otros.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, Jeremías predice el regreso del remanente de Israel del exilio, cuidadosamente reunido y guiado por el Señor. En la segunda lectura, Cristo es descrito como un sumo sacerdote llamado por Dios para hacer una ofrenda por nuestros pecados. En el Evangelio, Jesús sana al mendigo ciego Bartimeo, quien luego sigue a Jesús en *el camino*.

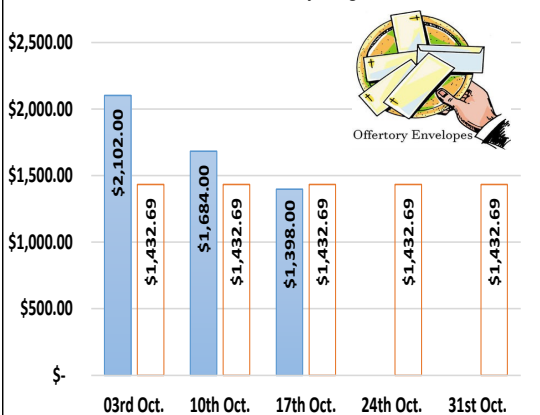

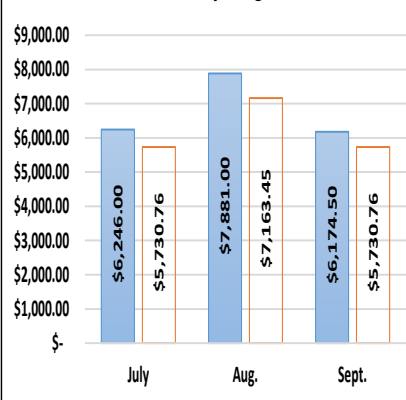
