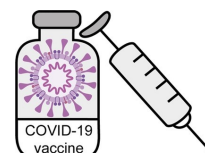

THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS MARY AND JOSEPH

FOCUS: Blessed are those who fear the Lord and walk in his ways.

On this Feast of the Holy Family, we celebrate God's Incarnation into a human family who loved, protected and taught him. They were holy because they were perfect in obedience and virtue; blessed because they feared the Lord and walked in his ways. We, too, may strive to attain this holiness, in our imitation of the Holy Family's example and through the grace of Christ.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In today's first reading, God promises Abram an heir, even though Abram is very old. Before too long Sarah, his wife, bears him a son. In the second reading, the author of Hebrews tells the story of Abraham (Abram) as an example of true faith in God. In the Gospel, Joseph and Mary take Jesus to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord. The devout and righteous Simeon beheld the child Jesus, and prayed to the Lord that he as the Lord's servant might now be dismissed for he had seen the salvation that had been promised. Simeon also foretold the destiny of Jesus and the suffering Mary would undergo.

ENFOQUE: Felices son quienes temen al Señor y siguen sus caminos.

Nosotros también podemos esforzarnos a alcanzar esta santidad, al imitar el ejemplo de la Sagrada Familia y por la gracia de Cristo.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura de hoy, Dios le promete a Abraham un heredero, aunque Abraham es muy anciano. En poco tiempo, Sara, su esposa, le da a luz un hijo. En la segunda lectura, el autor de Hebreos cuenta la historia de Abraham (Abram) como un ejemplo de verdadera fe en Dios. En el Evangelio, José y María lo trajeron a Jerusalén para presentar al Niño al Señor. El devoto y justo Simeón contempló al niño Jesús y oró al Señor para que ahora él, como siervo del Señor, fuera despedido, porque había visto la salvación que se había prometido. Simeón también predijo el destino de Jesús y el sufrimiento por el que pasaría María.

Collection Envelopes are available at the parish office and at the Sunday Mass's Please pick up your 2021 envelopes as soon as you can.

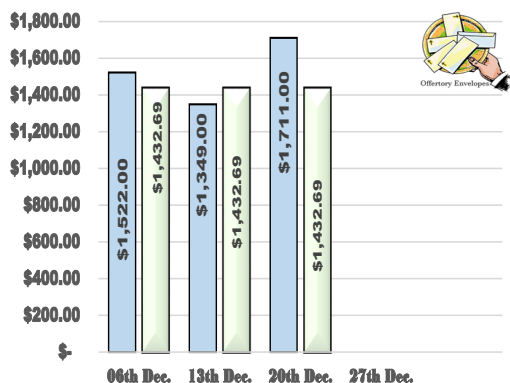

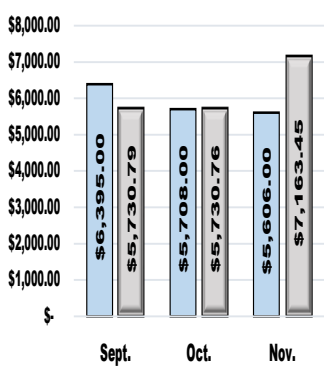
Los sobres estarán disponibles en la oficina parroquial y en la misa del domingo. Recoja los sobres de 2021 lo antes posible.
