## SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

**FOCUS:** Jesus is beloved Son and fulfillment of God's promises.

At this early point in our Lenten journey, our readings remind us of God's promises to humanity and his faithfulness to those promises. Full of the same hope that once spurred Abraham on to leave his homeland and Paul to preach the Gospel with commitment and fidelity, they now seek to encourage us in our Lenten disciplines.

### LITURGY OF THE WORD

The promises made to Abraham go beyond his wildest dreams – he will be the father of a great nation, as numerous as the stars in the night sky. Saint Paul challenges the Philippians to imitate him and to stand firm and faithful in the Lord. The glory of the Transfiguration gives us a glimpse of the glory of the risen Christ.

**ENFOQUE:** Jesús es el Hijo amado y el cumplimiento de las promesas de Dios.

### 5 Things you probable didn't know about St. Patrick

1. He wasn't Irish: Patrick was captured by Irish pirates and brought to Ireland from Scotland in the early 5th Century.
2. Experienced a (mystical) vision of the Irish asking him to teach them about Christ.
3. Having become a Bishop, he was sent back to Ireland. He preached first to the members of the royal family, and soon his audiences grew. He used the druid rituals as evangelizing tools.
4. He used a Shamrock to explain the Trinity because the Irish has a love for nature.
5. Instituted what is known as the Croagh Patrick Hike, where he prayed that Ireland would always keep her Christian Faith. To this day, young and old hikers follow that famous route in pilgrimage. (CatholicLink)

**Mayor Keller, Archbishop Wester, Local Charities Call on Albuquerque to Come Together in Support of Asylum Seekers**

Albuquerque, NM — In the spirit of the #OneAlbuquerque movement, Mayor Tim Keller, Archbishop John C. Wester, and a range of local service providers and charity organizations came together today to give an update on asylum seekers traveling through Albuquerque and how Burqueños can help.

A total of just under 300 migrants have been moving through Albuquerque over several days on their way to sponsor families and homes throughout the United States, where they will await review of their asylum applications. The group is made up of families with children and individuals who presented themselves at a point of entry to formally and legally request asylum according to the process laid out by federal law. As the agencies that handle these claims and oversee operations at the border continue to see high numbers of asylum applicants, additional groups are likely to travel through Albuquerque again in the coming weeks and months.

“I have never been so proud to be a citizen of such an amazing community,” Archbishop John Wester said. “These brothers and sisters of ours have inalienable rights given by God Himself. We believe they are created in the image and likeness of God, as we all are, and so we reach out to them, and keep them in prayer. We need to continue the donations; give your time, talent or treasures, or all three – whatever you can do - to help our brothers and sisters.”

The efforts are being funded by private charities and non-profit organizations. The City of Albuquerque is helping with resource coordination and communications in the efforts. Mayor Keller also provided information to Albuquerque residents who want to lend a hand to those in need.
