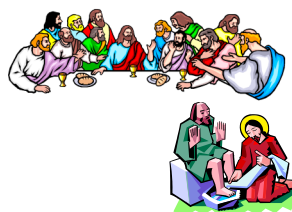

PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

FOCUS: We are invited to accompany Jesus as he faces betrayal, abandonment, suffering and death.

Today we commemorate the passion of Jesus. Through the Gospel reading, we are invited into the story, to be present with Jesus as he experiences his arrest, suffering and death. We reflect upon the various figures in the Gospel, those who actively contributed to his persecution, those who stood at a distance, and those who would not partake of the evil that was done. As Christians, we are called to remember the events of Palm Sunday whenever we encounter suffering, whether our own or others.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the procession with palms, Luke recounts the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem, where people proclaimed, Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord. In the first reading, Isaiah prophesies about the Lord's servant. In the second reading from Philippians, Paul quotes a hymn that tells of the "emptying" and subsequent exaltation of Christ. In the Gospel, Luke recounts the events of Christ's passion: from the meal with his Apostles, to his agony on the Mount of Olives, and then his arrest, crucifixion, death and burial.

ENFOQUE: Estamos invitados a acompañar a Jesús cuando se enfrenta a la traición, el abandono, el sufrimiento y la muerte.

Hoy conmemoramos la pasión de Jesús. A través de la lectura del Evangelio, somos invitados a su historia, para estar presentes con Jesús cuando experimenta su arresto, sufrimiento y muerte. Reflexionamos sobre las diversas figuras en el Evangelio, aquellos que contribuyeron activamente a su persecución, aquellos que se mantuvieron a distancia y aquellos que no participarían del mal que se cometió. Como cristianos, estamos llamados a recordar los eventos del Domingo de Ramos cada vez que nos encontramos con el sufrimiento, ya sea propio o ajeno.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la procesión con palmas, Lucas relata la entrada de Jesús en Jerusalén, donde la gente proclamó: Bendito el rey que viene en el nombre del Señor. En la primera lectura, Isaías profetiza acerca del siervo del Señor. En la segunda lectura de Filipenses, Pablo cita un himno que habla del "vaciamiento" y la subsiguiente exaltación de Cristo. En el Evangelio, Lucas relata los acontecimientos de la pasión de Cristo: desde la cena con sus apóstoles, hasta su agonía en el Monte de los Olivos, y luego su arresto, crucifixión, muerte y sepultura.

Palm Sunday reminds us that the reign of Christ is far greater than any the mind of man could ever conceive or plan. Man looked for someone to fight their battles in the present day world. Yet God had the ultimate plan of sending His Son to fight the final battle over death. This is the greatness of why we celebrate this week. Because of Christ's ultimate sacrifice, we can be set free of death.

"Jesus said to her, 'I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies,' John 11:25

We have so much to be grateful for this week. The enemy knows that, and you can bet, he's going to do everything he can to try and distract us away from the true meaning of what this Holy Week means. Don't let him win. In this Holy Week, may God direct our thoughts and attention towards what matters most, Jesus Christ our King... Let's choose to focus on worshipping our Lord, thanking Him for the gift of His sacrifice, celebrating the power of the Resurrection, and the new life found in Him alone.
