

THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FOCUS: Jesus summons us to him and then sends us out as messengers to proclaim his kingdom.

The Christian life is one of following the way of Christ. Jesus calls us out of our worldliness, out of our habits and attachments, to follow his way. And after we encounter the Lord, he sends us out to proclaim the truth of his kingdom.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the reading from the First Book of Kings, the Lord tells Elijah to find Elisha and anoint him as prophet to succeed [him]. Elisha, though he wants to wait until he can say goodbye to his parents, nevertheless slaughters his oxen and follows. In the second reading, Paul writes to the Galatians about the freedom that Christ came to bring us which, if we live by the Spirit, allows us to not be controlled by the desires of the flesh. In the Gospel, Jesus is making his final journey to Jerusalem, and tells those who want to follow him that they must do so without delay.

ENFOQUE: Jesús nos llama a él y luego nos envía como mensajeros para proclamar su reino.

La vida cristiana es seguir el camino de Cristo. Jesús nos llama a salir de nuestra mundanalidad, de nuestros hábitos y apegos, y seguir su camino. Y después de encontrarnos con el Señor, él nos envía a proclamar la verdad de su reino.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la lectura del Primer Libro de los Reyes, el Señor le dice a Elías que busque a Eliseo y lo unja como profeta para seguirlo. Eliseo, aunque quiere esperar hasta que pueda despedirse de sus padres, sacrifica a sus bueyes y lo sigue. En la segunda lectura, Pablo escribe a los Gálatas sobre la libertad que Cristo vino a traernos, la cual, si vivimos por el Espíritu, no permite que seamos controlados por los deseos de la carne. En el Evangelio, Jesús está haciendo su último viaje a Jerusalén, y les dice a los que quieren seguirlo que deben hacerlo sin demora.

John the Baptist was a contemporary of Christ who was known for evangelization and his baptizing of Jesus Christ. John the Baptist was born through the intercession of God to Zachariah and Elizabeth, who was otherwise too old to bear children. According to scriptures, the Angel Gabriel visited Elizabeth and Zachariah to tell them they would have a son and that they should name him John. Zachariah was skeptical and for this he was rendered mute until the time his son was born and named John, in fulfillment of God's will. When Elizabeth was pregnant with John, she was visited by Mary, and John leapt in her womb. This revealed to Elizabeth that the child Mary carried was to be the Son of God. John began public ministry around 30 AD, and was known for attracting large crowds across the province of Judaea and around the Jordan River. When Jesus came to him to be baptized, John recognized him and said, "It is I who need baptism from you." Jesus told John to baptize Him anyway, which he did, whereupon the heavens opened, and the Spirit of God was seen like a dove. The voice of God spoke, saying, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

John instructed his followers to turn to Christ, calling Him the "Lamb of God" and these people were among the first Christians. Following his baptism of Christ, John's popularity grew so much that he alarmed King Herod. Herod ordered him arrested and imprisoned. John spoke with Herod on several occasions and condemned his marriage to his half-brother's wife.

This condemnation would be his downfall as King Herod promised to grant a wish to his daughter. In revenge for John the Baptist's condemnation of her mother's scandalous marriage to Herod, she asked for John's head. King Herod reluctantly obliged. John the Baptist died sometime between 33 and 36 AD.

John the Baptist's feast day is June 24, and the anniversary of his death is August 29.

Juan el Bautista fue un contemporáneo de Cristo, conocido por la evangelización y el bautismo de Jesucristo. Juan el Bautista nació por intercesión de Dios a Zacarías y Isabel, quienes de otra manera eran demasiado viejos para tener hijos. Según las Escrituras, el Ángel Gabriel visitó a Elizabeth y Zachariah para decirles que tendrían un hijo y que deberían llamarlo John. Zachariah se mostró escéptico y por eso se quedó mudo hasta el momento en que nació su hijo y se llamó Juan, en cumplimiento de la voluntad de Dios. Cuando Elizabeth estaba embarazada de John, Mary la visitó y John saltó en su vientre. Esto le reveló a Elizabeth que el niño que María llevaba era el Hijo de Dios. John comenzó el ministerio público alrededor del 30 d. C., y era conocido por atraer grandes multitudes a través de la provincia de Judea y alrededor del río Jordán. Cuando Jesús se acercó a él para ser bautizado, Juan lo reconoció y le dijo: "Yo soy el que necesita el bautismo de ti". Jesús le dijo a Juan que lo bautizara de todos modos, lo cual hizo, con lo cual se abrieron los cielos y el Espíritu de Dios se vio como una paloma. La voz de Dios habló, diciendo: "Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien tengo complacencia". Juan ordenó a sus seguidores que se volvieran a Cristo, llamándolo "Cordero de Dios" y estas personas estaban entre los primeros cristianos. Tras su bautismo de Cristo, la popularidad de Juan creció tanto que alarmó al rey Herodes. Herodes ordenó su detención y encarcelamiento. Juan habló con Herodes en varias ocasiones y condenó su matrimonio con la esposa de su hermanastro. Esta condena sería su caída, ya que el rey Herodes prometió conceder un deseo a su hija. En venganza por la condena de Juan Bautista del escandaloso matrimonio de su madre con Herodes, ella le pidió la cabeza de Juan. El rey Herodes obedeció de mala gana. Juan el Bautista murió en algún momento entre el 33 y el 36 dC. El día de la fiesta de Juan el Bautista es el 24 de junio, y el aniversario de su muerte es el 29 de agosto y a veces se celebra con una segunda fiesta. Juan el Bautista es el santo patrón de Jordania, Puerto Rico, el Canadá francés y muchos otros lugares.
