Question: Why do Catholics pray to Mary and the saints? **Answer:** One of the statements of faith we make when we pray the Nicene Creed and the Apostles Creed is that we believe in "the communion of saints." The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us that this communion (another word for community) includes all the faithful on earth, the souls in Purgatory, and the blessed women, men, and children who are in heaven. This teaching is grounded in our belief that, through Baptism, we are united with Christ and to one another with bonds that are stronger even than death. And so from the time of the early Church, Christians have turned to other believers for prayers and assistance, including those who have gone before us, confident that God hears the prayers of all of His children. While we ask the saints (and one another) for prayers and support, we remember that the saints join us in prayer. But it is God who blesses and sanctifies us. When we think of Mary and the saints in heaven, we have to remember that we can turn to them for intercession and assistance because they were faulted, limited human beings, just like us. This means that they are able to understand our struggles, doubts, fears, joys, and hopes. But as we learn their stories, we can also begin to recognize that they stand out in the history of the Church because they persevered in their commitment to follow Christ. Whether they were ordained, vowed religious, martyrs, husbands, wives, or even children, they show us that holiness is possible. We can not only follow their example but also benefit from their prayerful support. Our devotion to the saints and gratitude for their witness, prayers, and protection should also be an inspiration for us, especially when we become aware of the needs of others or when others ask us to pray for them. We are called to share the blessings we receive. This is also part of our own journey of growing in holiness.

THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FOCUS: Putting Jesus first is our challenge.

Once again Jesus discusses the challenge of living the Gospel. Faithful discipleship comes with demands. But we are not to keep the Gospel message to ourselves – it must be proclaimed and lived no matter what the cost. For those who are faithful, the reward will be newness of life.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, a woman of influence who consistently offers hospitality to Elisha is rewarded with the promise of a son. Saint Paul reminds the Roman community that through baptism they share in the death and resurrection of Christ. In the Gospel, Jesus tells his Apostles that whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me.

ENFOQUE: Poner a Jesús primero es nuestro desafío.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, una mujer influyente que constantemente ofrece hospitalidad a Eliseo es recompensada con la promesa de un hijo. San Pablo recuerda a la comunidad romana que a través del bautismo comparten la muerte y resurrección de Cristo. En el Evangelio, Jesús les dice a sus apóstoles que quien no tome su cruz y me siga no es digno de mí.





John the Baptist was a contemporary of Christ who was known for evangelization and his baptizing of Jesus Christ.

John the Baptist was born through the intercession of God to Zachariah and Elizabeth, who was otherwise too old to bear children. According to scriptures, the Angel Gabriel visited Elizabeth and Zachariah to tell them they would have a son and that they should name him John. Zachariah was skeptical and for this he was rendered mute until the time his son was born and named John, in fulfillment of God's will.

When Elizabeth was pregnant with John, she was visited by Mary, and John leapt in her womb. This revealed to Elizabeth that the child Mary carried was to be the Son of God.

John began public ministry around 30 AD, and was known for attracting large crowds across the province of Judea and around the Jordan River. When Jesus came to him to be baptized, John recognized him and said, "It is I who need baptism from you."

Jesus told John to baptize Him anyway, which he did, whereupon the heavens opened, and the Spirit of God was seen like a dove. The voice of God spoke, saying, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

John instructed his followers to turn to Christ, calling Him the "Lamb of God" and these people were among the first Christians.

Following his baptism of Christ, John's popularity grew so much that he alarmed King Herod. Herod ordered him arrested and imprisoned.

John spoke with Herod on several occasions and condemned his marriage to his half-brother's wife.

This condemnation would be his downfall as King Herod promised to grant a wish to his daughter. In revenge for John the Baptist's condemnation of her mother's scandalous marriage to Herod, she asked for John's head. King Herod reluctantly obliged. John the Baptist died sometime between 33 and 36 AD.



Juan el Bautista fue contemporáneo de Cristo, conocido por la evangelización y su bautismo de Jesucristo.

Juan el Bautista nació a través de la intercesión de Dios con Zacarías e Isabel, que de otro modo era demasiado mayor para tener hijos. Según las Escrituras, el Ángel Gabriel visitó a Elizabeth y Zacarías para decirles que tendrían un hijo y que deberían llamarlo John. Zacarías era escéptico y por esto se quedó mudo hasta el momento en que nació su hijo y se llamó Juan, en cumplimiento de la voluntad de Dios.

Cuando Elizabeth estaba embarazada de John, Mary la visitó y John saltó a su vientre. Esto le reveló a Elizabeth que el niño que llevó María debía ser el Hijo de Dios.

John comenzó el ministerio público alrededor del año 30 DC, y era conocido por atraer grandes multitudes a través de la provincia de Judea y alrededor del río Jordán. Cuando Jesús vino a él para bautizarse, Juan lo reconoció y le dijo: "Soy yo quien necesita el bautismo de usted".

Jesús le dijo a Juan que lo bautizara de todos modos, lo cual hizo, con lo cual los cielos se abrieron, y el Espíritu de Dios fue visto como una paloma. La voz de Dios habló, diciendo: "Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien tengo complacencia".

John instruyó a sus seguidores a volverse a Cristo, llamándolo el "Cordero de Dios" y estas personas se encontraban entre los primeros cristianos.

Después de su bautismo de Cristo, la popularidad de Juan creció tanto que alarmó al rey Herodes. Herodes ordenó su arresto y encarcelamiento.

John habló con Herodes en varias ocasiones y condenó su matrimonio con la esposa de su medio hermano.

Esta condena sería su caída cuando el rey Herodes prometió concederle un deseo a su hija. En venganza por la condena de Juan el Bautista del escandaloso matrimonio de su madre con Herodes, ella pidió la cabeza de Juan. El rey Herodes aceptó de mala gana. Juan el Bautista murió en algún momento entre 33 y 36 d. C.
