TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FOCUS: Trust in and follow the way of Jesus.

Peter can be excused for thinking as a human does, for he is human! But what gets him in trouble is his mistaken idea that he knows better than Jesus – that he knows better how Jesus ought to carry out his mission. This is reminiscent of the Fall: Pride in one’s own knowledge over that of God’s. We’re all susceptible to that, and Jesus reminds Peter – and us – that his way is the way. All we need to do is trust, and follow.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

Jeremiah accuses the Lord of duping him, for his prophecies are met with laughter and mocking, derision and reproach. Paul encourages the Romans to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice. In the Gospel, Jesus reveals that he must suffer greatly, and Peter attempts to dissuade him. Jesus accuses Peter of thinking not as God does, but as human beings do. He then tells his disciples that in order to follow him, they must take up their cross.

ENFOQUE: Confía y sigue el camino de Jesús.

Se puede excusar a Pedro por pensar como un humano, ¡porque es humano! Pero lo que lo mete en problemas es su idea errónea de que él sabe mejor que Jesús, cómo Jesús debe llevar a cabo su misión. Esto recuerda a la Caída: Tener orgullo en el propio conocimiento de uno en vez de en el de Dios. Todos somos susceptibles a eso, y Jesús le recuerda a Pedro, y a nosotros, que su camino es el camino. Lo único que necesitamos hacer es confiar y seguir.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

Jeremías acusa al Señor de engañarlo, porque sus profecías son recibidas con risas y burlas, oprobio y escarnio. Pablo anima a los romanos a [presentar] sus cuerpos como sacrificio vivo. En el Evangelio, Jesús revela que debe sufrir mucho, y Pedro intenta disuadirlo. Jesús acusa a Pedro de no [pensar] en las cosas de Dios, sino en las de los hombres. Luego les dice a sus discípulos que, para seguirlo, deben tomar su cruz.

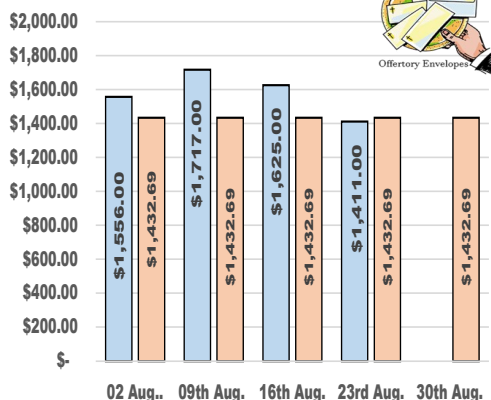

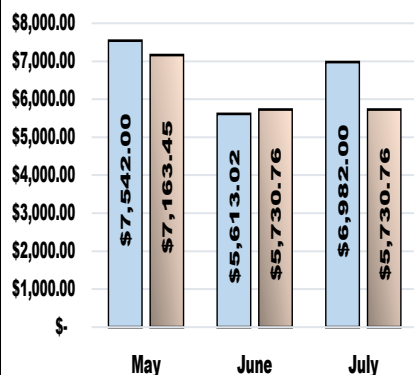
