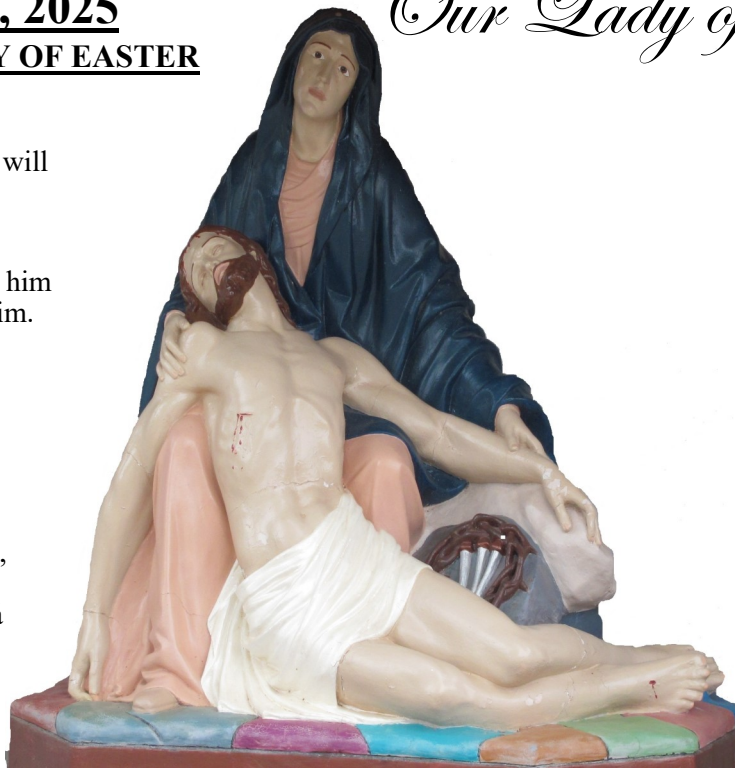

## SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER SEXTO DOMINGO DE PASCUA

**FOCUS:** Home to the Holy Spirit, our hearts become the eternal dwelling place of Christ.

Christians on pilgrimage to the Holy Land are often greeted with the words, "Welcome home." Indeed, the Church began in Jerusalem; Jesus died right outside of its walls; and it is also home to the first council recounted in today's first reading. Truly, our home is not in a particular place but in Christ, through the gift of the Holy Spirit. Jesus gives light to the new Jerusalem, which is the eternal city, the kingdom of God.

### LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, the Apostles send a letter to Antioch explaining which practices [with regard to the Mosaic law] are necessary for Gentiles who have come to believe in the Gospel. In the second reading, John describes his vision of the new Jerusalem, which shines with Christ's eternal light. Jesus, in the Gospel, foretells the coming of the Advocate. The Holy Spirit, Jesus tells his disciples, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you.

**ENFOQUE:** Hogar del Espíritu Santo, nuestros corazones se convierten en la morada eterna de Cristo.

Los cristianos que peregrinan a Tierra Santa son recibidos a menudo con las palabras: "Bienvenidos a casa". De hecho, la Iglesia comenzó en Jerusalén; Jesús murió justo fuera de sus muros, y también es el hogar del primer concilio relatado en la primera lectura de hoy. En verdad, nuestro hogar no está en un lugar concreto, sino en Cristo a través del don del Espíritu Santo. Jesús ilumina la nueva Jerusalén, que es la ciudad eterna, el reino de Dios.

### LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, los Apóstoles envían una carta a Antioquía, en la que explican qué prácticas [con respecto a la ley mosaica] son necesarias para los gentiles que han llegado a creer en el Evangelio. En la segunda lectura, Juan describe su visión de la nueva Jerusalén, que brilla con la luz eterna de Cristo. Jesús, en el Evangelio, predice la venida del Abogado. El Espíritu Santo, dice Jesús a sus discípulos, les enseñará todo y les recordará lo que les he dicho.

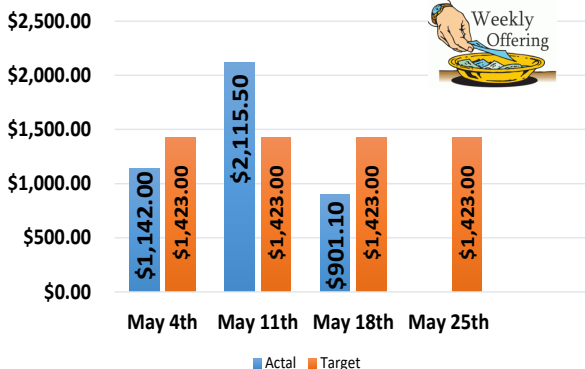

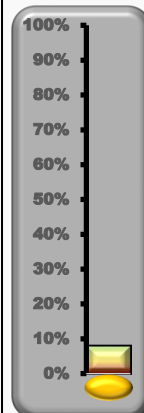
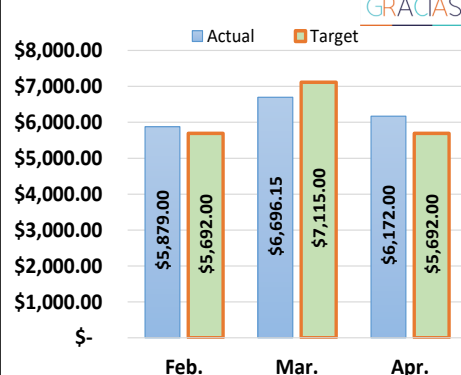
