SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

SEGUNDO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

FOCUS: We must bring the light of Christ to the world.

The servants of God are lights to the world. There is no way to serve God without bringing light to others. Isaiah and John the Baptist were both called lights. Jesus is, of course, the light of the world, but he also desires that his followers bring his true light to the world.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Isaiah prophesies that Israel will be gathered to the Lord. In the second reading, Paul reminds the Corinthians of their call to be holy. In the Gospel, John the Baptist points to Jesus, calling him the Lamb of God, and testifies to what he saw at the baptism of Jesus.

ENFOQUE: Tenemos que llevar la luz de Cristo al mundo.

Los siervos de Dios son luces para el mundo. No hay forma de servir a Dios sin llevar luz a los demás. Tanto Isaías como Juan el Bautista fueron llamados "luces". Jesús es, por supuesto, la luz del mundo, pero también desea que sus seguidores lleven su verdadera luz al mundo.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, Isaías profetiza que Israel se reunirá con el Señor. En la segunda lectura, Pablo recuerda a los corintios su llamada a ser santos. En el Evangelio, Juan el Bautista señala a Jesús, llamándole el Cordero de Dios, y da testimonio de lo que vio en el bautismo de Jesús.

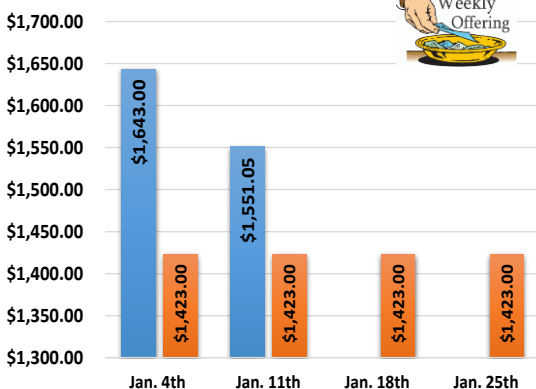

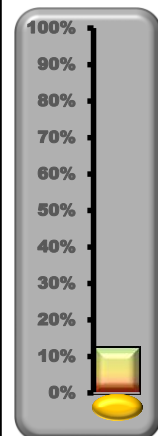
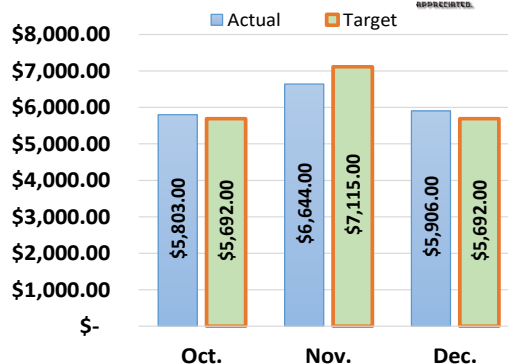
