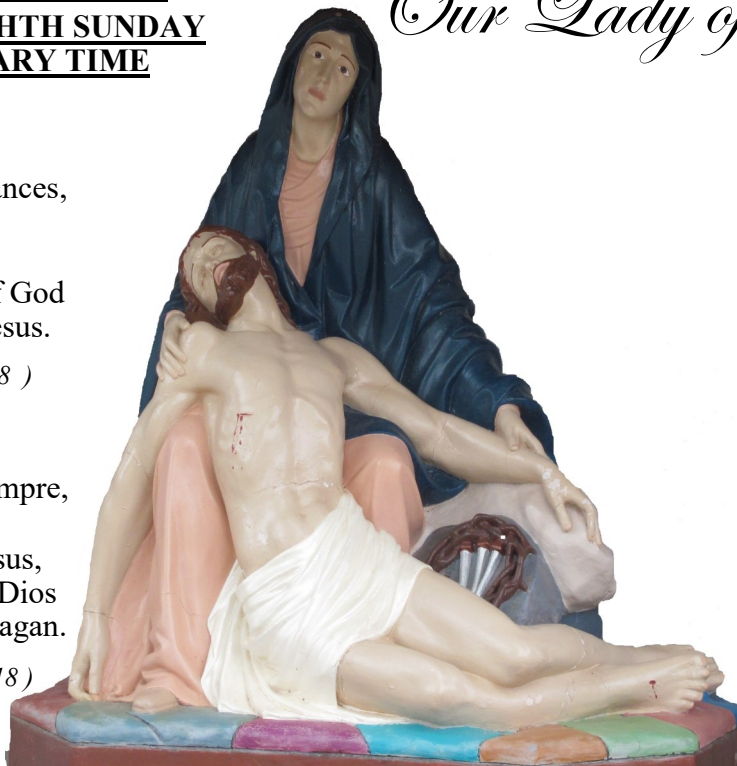

TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
VIGÉSIMO OCTAVO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

FOCUS: If we persevere, we shall also reign with him.

Today's readings feature those in extremely difficult circumstances finding hope and new life in their faith. Naaman is cleansed, Paul hopes in God in the face of trial, and desperate lepers are completely healed. In each of these examples, we see the transformative power of faith and the abundant power and grace of God. May the Lord increase and sustain us in faith so as to be strident witnesses of his love and mercy to the world.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Naaman cleanses himself in the Jordan, declaring the God of Israel as the only God. In the second reading, Saint Paul urges perseverance for Christ in the face of persecution. In the Gospel, Jesus heals ten lepers. Only one, a Samaritan, returns to give thanks to him. His faith has saved him.

ENFOQUE: Si somos constantes, reinaremos con Él.

Las lecturas de hoy presentan a quienes, en circunstancias extremadamente difíciles, encuentran esperanza y nueva vida en su fe. Naamán se limpia, Pablo espera en Dios ante la prueba y los leprosos desesperados se curan por completo. En cada uno de estos ejemplos, vemos el poder transformador de la fe, así como el abundante poder y gracia de Dios. Que el Señor nos aumente y nos sostenga en la fe para que seamos testigos estridentes de su amor y su misericordia ante el mundo.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, Naamán se limpia en el Jordán, declarando al Dios de Israel como el único Dios. En la segunda lectura, San Pablo exhorta a perseverar por Cristo frente a la persecución. En el Evangelio, Jesús sana a diez leprosos. Sólo uno, un samaritano, vuelve para darle las gracias. Su fe le ha salvado.

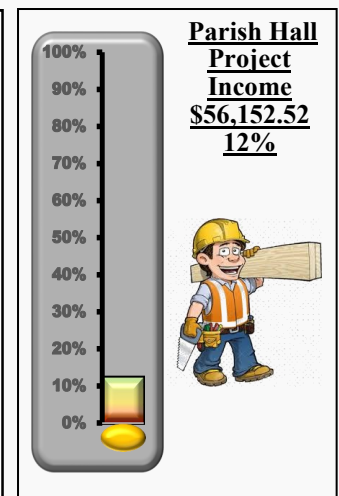
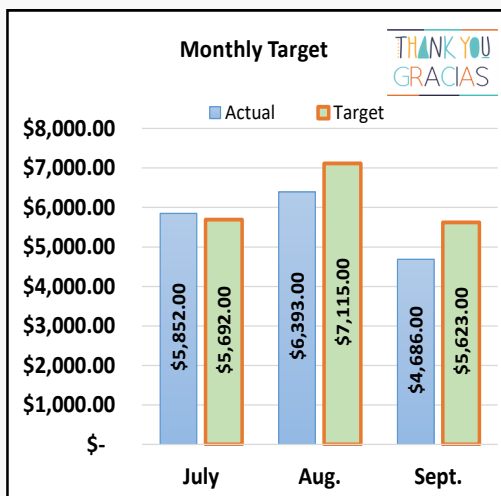
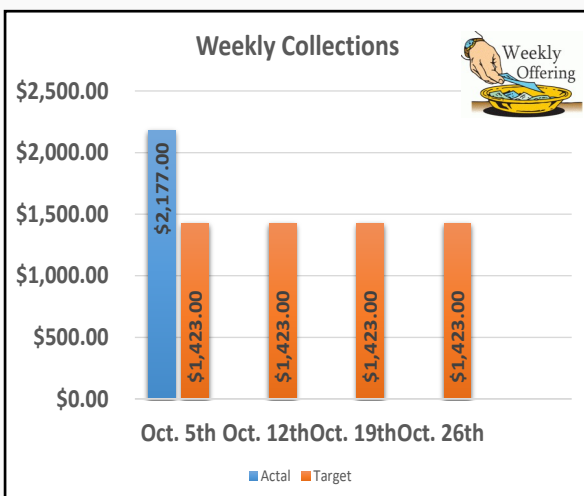
