THIRTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME TRIGESIMO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

FOCUS: Humility before the Lord is its own righteousness.

In the spiritual life, it is tempting to look at others' motivations and behaviors and compare them to ourselves. We may even comfort ourselves with the thought that at least we are "not like them." The Lord reminds us that our focus should be on examining our own actions, recognizing our own sins, and humbly repenting for these, seeking God's mercy.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Sirach speaks of the Lord as a God of justice ... He hears the cry of the oppressed and the petitions of the lowly. In the second reading, with the end of his earthly life nearing, Paul expresses continued trust in the Lord's help and eternal reward. In the Gospel, Jesus addresses those who were convinced of their own righteousness with a parable of a Pharisee and tax collector praying in the temple area.

ENFOQUE: La humildad ante el Señor es su propia justicia.

En la vida espiritual, resulta tentador observar tanto las motivaciones como los comportamientos de los demás y compararlos con los nuestros. Incluso podemos consolarnos pensando que al menos "no somos como ellos". El Señor nos recuerda que nuestra atención debe centrarse en examinar nuestras propias acciones, reconocer nuestros propios pecados y arrepentirnos humildemente de ellos, buscando la misericordia de Dios.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, el Eclesiástico habla del Señor como un juez... No hace distinción de personas: no se muestra parcial contra el pobre y escucha la súplica del oprimido. En la segunda lectura, al acercarse el final de su vida terrenal, Pablo expresa su confianza continua en la ayuda del Señor y en su recompensa eterna. En el Evangelio, Jesús se dirige a algunos que se tenían por justos y despreciaban a los demás con una parábola de un fariseo y un recaudador de impuestos que oraban en la zona del templo.

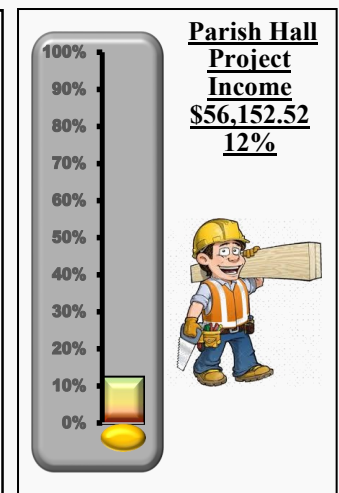
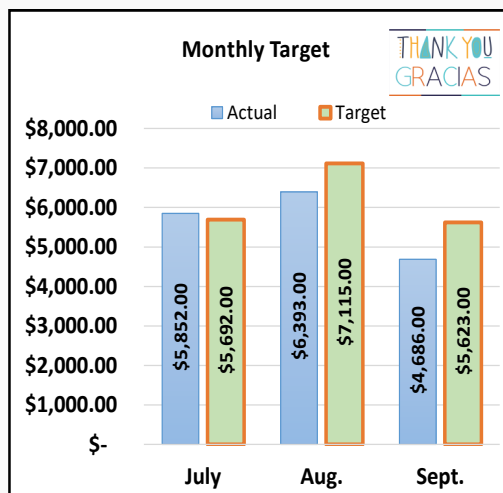
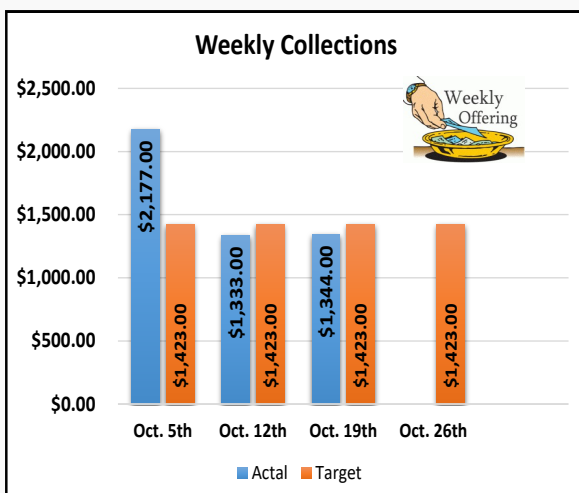
