



FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

QUINTO DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

FOCUS: *Those who have the Spirit of Christ belong to him and will share his resurrection.*

Today's Gospel is not just about the resurrection of Lazarus. It is also about ours. Because the Spirit lives in us, death has no power over us. We, too, will share Christ's resurrection. May this hope inspire and guide us through these final days of Lent.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In Ezekiel, the Lord says he will open the graves and breathe his spirit in them. In Romans, Saint Paul teaches that we belong to Christ in that we share his Spirit. In the Gospel, Jesus discovers that his friend Lazarus has died. Although he had been dead for four days, Jesus brings Lazarus back from the dead.

ENFOQUE: *Los que tienen el Espíritu de Cristo le pertenecen y compartirán su resurrección.*

El Evangelio de hoy no trata sólo de la resurrección de Lázaro, sino también de la nuestra. Porque el Espíritu vive en nosotros, la muerte no tiene poder sobre nosotros. También compartiremos la resurrección de Cristo. Que esta esperanza nos inspire y nos guíe en estos últimos días de Cuaresma.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En Ezequiel, el Señor dice que abrirá las tumbas e insuflará su espíritu en ellas. En Romanos, San Pablo enseña que pertenecemos a Cristo en la medida en que compartimos su Espíritu. En el Evangelio, Jesús descubre que su amigo Lázaro ha muerto. Aunque llevaba muerto cuatro días, Jesús lo resucita.




Each year, tens of thousands of pilgrims travel to this holy shrine to walk in the footsteps of Jesus, seeking spiritual renewal, healing, and penance during the holiest days of the Christian calendar.

To ensure the pilgrimage is accessible to all, the North Central Regional Transit District (NCRTD) Blue Bus will be operating on Good Friday with special service to Santuario de Chimayó, in addition to fare-free service from Española.
