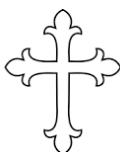

# THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME DECIMOTERCER DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

**FOCUS:** *Whoever receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet's reward.*

In the first reading we hear about the woman from Shunem who served God by her hospitality to his servant, Elisha. She served Elisha because she knew he was a holy man of God. Jesus promises that whoever receives those he has sent receives not only him, but his heavenly Father as well. When we open our hearts to receive the Lord and his messengers, we receive the best reward: God's divine presence with us.

## LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Elisha is cared for by a woman of influence; Elisha promises that God will give her a son in return for her generosity. In the Letter to the Romans, we are reminded that we are buried through baptism in Christ's death and that we shall also live with him. In the Gospel, Jesus calls us to take up our cross and follow him.

**ENFOQUE:** *El que recibe a un profeta por ser profeta, tendrá la recompensa de un profeta.*

Cuando abrimos nuestros corazones para recibir al Señor y a sus mensajeros, recibimos la mejor recompensa: la presencia divina de Dios con nosotros.

En la primera lectura, Eliseo es atendido por una mujer influyente, quien le promete que Dios le dará un hijo a cambio de su generosidad. En la Carta a los Romanos, se nos recuerda que hemos sido sepultados por el bautismo en la muerte de Cristo y que también viviremos con él. En el Evangelio, Jesús nos llama a tomar nuestra cruz y seguirlo.

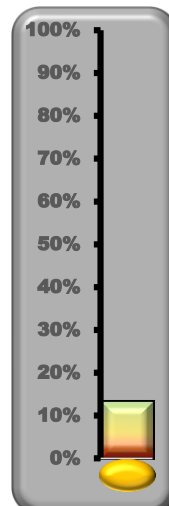
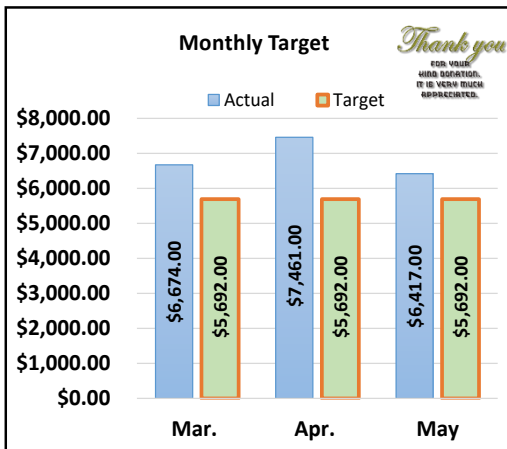
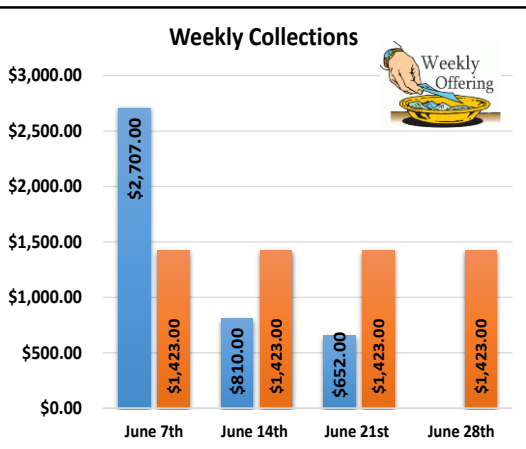
