

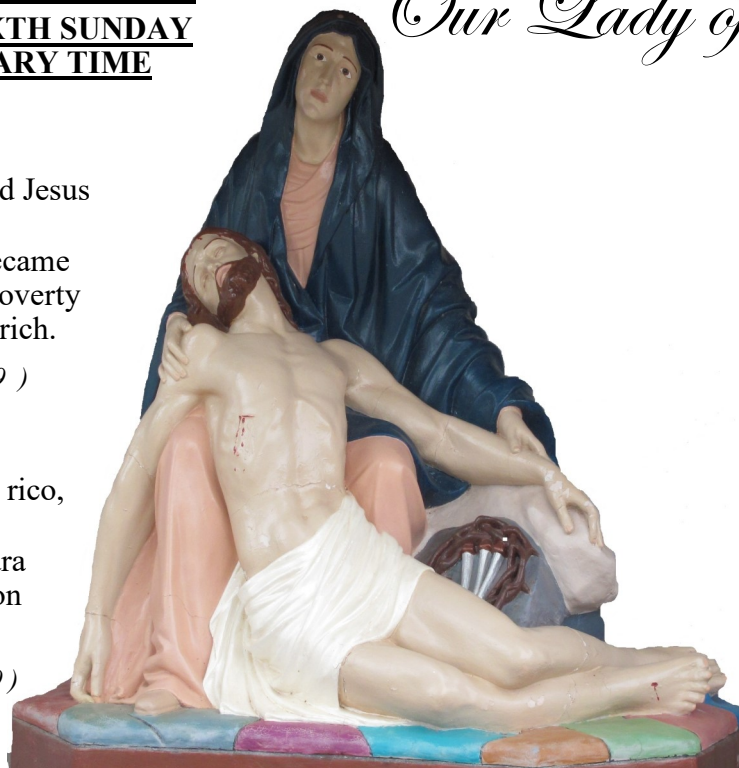

TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME VIGÉSIMO SEXTO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

FOCUS: Blessed is he who secures justice for the oppressed, gives food to the hungry.

The word of God teaches us to pursue righteousness rather than selfishness. When we ourselves suffer, as Jesus did for us, we grow in humility and empathy toward others. We learn to re-evaluate our priorities and place love for God and our neighbor above pleasure, power, and wealth. Though not a good in itself, suffering can change our hearts, move us to repentance, and return us to God.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, God issues a warning through Amos to complacent and self-serving Israelites. In the second reading, Paul charges Timothy to live up to his call as a man of God until the appearance of our Lord Jesus Christ. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the rich man and Lazarus. The rich man received what was good during his lifetime while ignoring Lazarus' suffering. In death, their situations are reversed.

ENFOQUE: Bendito el que nos libró de nuestros opresores, que da alimento a todos los vivientes.

La palabra de Dios nos enseña a perseguir la justicia en lugar del egoísmo. Cuando nosotros mismos sufrimos, como Jesús hizo por nosotros, crecemos en humildad y empatía hacia los demás. Aprendemos a reevaluar nuestras prioridades y a situar el amor a Dios y a nuestro prójimo por encima del placer, el poder y la riqueza. Aunque no es un bien en sí mismo, el sufrimiento puede cambiar nuestros corazones, movernos al arrepentimiento y devolvernos a Dios.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

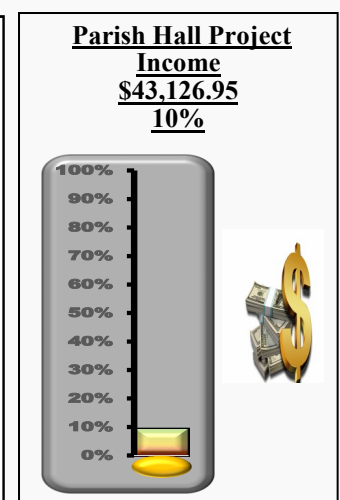
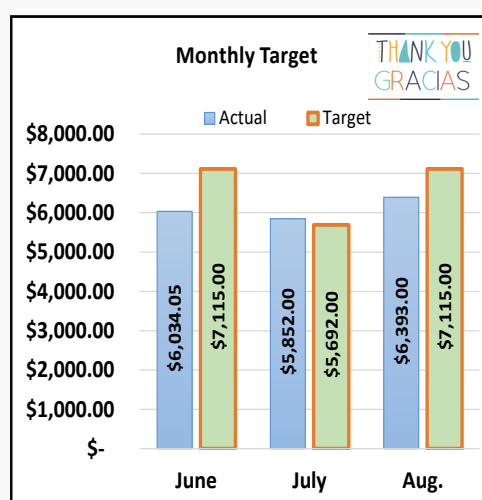
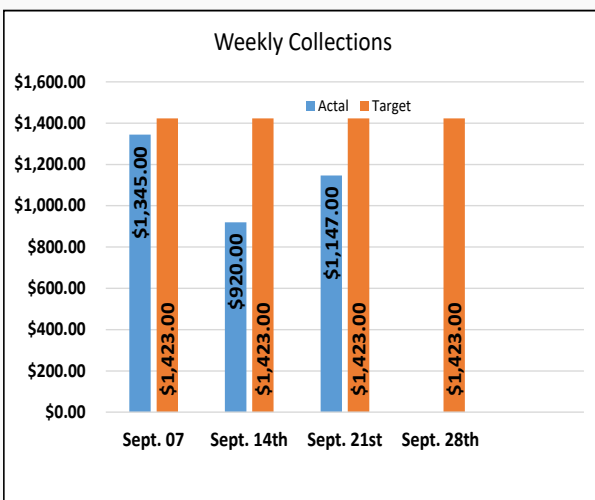
