According to the Catholic Encyclopedia,

the Apocryphal Date for Joseph's birth is 90 BC in Bethlehem and the Apocryphal Date of his death is July 20, AD 18 in Nazareth. Joseph is the patron saint of the dying because, assuming he died before Jesus' public life, he died with Jesus and Mary close to him, the way we all would like to leave this earth.

Joseph is also patron saint of the Universal Church, families, fathers, expectant mothers (pregnant women), travelers, immigrants, house sellers and buyers, craftsmen, engineers, and working people in general. We celebrate two feast days for Joseph: March 19 for Joseph the Husband of Mary and May 1 for Joseph the Worker. March 19 has been the most commonly celebrated feast day for Joseph, and it wasn't until 1955 that Pope Pius XII established the Feast of "St. Joseph the Worker" to be celebrated on May 1. This is also May Day (International Workers' Day) and believed to reflect Joseph's status as the patron of workers.

Según la Enciclopedia Católica, la fecha apócrifa del nacimiento de José es el año 90 a. C. en Belén y la fecha apócrifa de su muerte es el 20 de julio del año 18 d. C. en Nazaret. José es el santo patrono de los moribundos porque, suponiendo que murió antes de la vida pública de Jesús, murió con Jesús y María cerca de él, como a todos nos gustaría dejar esta tierra.

José es también el santo patrono de la Iglesia Universal, de las familias, los padres, las mujeres embarazadas, los viajeros, los inmigrantes, los vendedores y compradores de casas, los artesanos, los ingenieros y los trabajadores en general.

Celebramos dos días festivos en honor a José: el 19 de marzo, en honor a José, esposo de María, y el 1 de mayo, en honor a José, obrero. El 19 de marzo ha sido la festividad más celebrada en honor a San José, y no fue hasta 1955 que el Papa Pío XII estableció la festividad de "San José Obrero" para que se celebrara el 1 de mayo. Este día también es el Primero de Mayo (Día Internacional de los Trabajadores) y se cree que refleja el estatus de José como patrón de los trabajadores.

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

FOCUS: Stand firm in faith.

This season of Lent prepares us for Easter, when we will celebrate the Lord's resurrection. In today's Gospel Peter, John, and James get a glimpse of Jesus' glorified body. This is the type of body that Paul tells the Philippians we will one day have, as long as we stand firm in our faith – not only in Christ's resurrection, but also in his cross.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, God makes a covenant with Abram, promising descendants as numerous as the stars and land for them to inhabit. Paul tells the Philippians to imitate him, conducting themselves not as enemies of the cross, but standing firm in the Lord. In the Gospel, Jesus is transfigured on the mountain; Moses and Elijah appear with him in glory.

ENFOQUE: Manténgase firme en la fe.

Esta temporada de Cuaresma nos prepara para la Pascua, cuando celebraremos la resurrección del Señor. En el Evangelio de hoy, Pedro, Juan y Santiago vislumbran el cuerpo glorificado de Jesús. Este es el tipo de cuerpo que Pablo dice a los filipenses que algún día tendremos, siempre que nos mantengamos firmes en nuestra fe, no sólo en la resurrección de Cristo, sino también en su cruz.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, Dios hace un pacto con Abram, prometiéndole descendientes tan numerosos como las estrellas y tierra para que la habiten. Pablo dice a los filipenses que le imiten, comportándose no como enemigos de la cruz, sino como firmes en el Señor. En el Evangelio, Jesús se transfigura en la montaña; Moisés y Elías aparecen con él en la gloria.

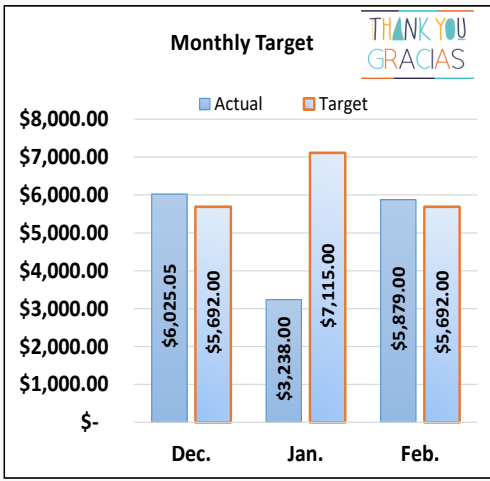
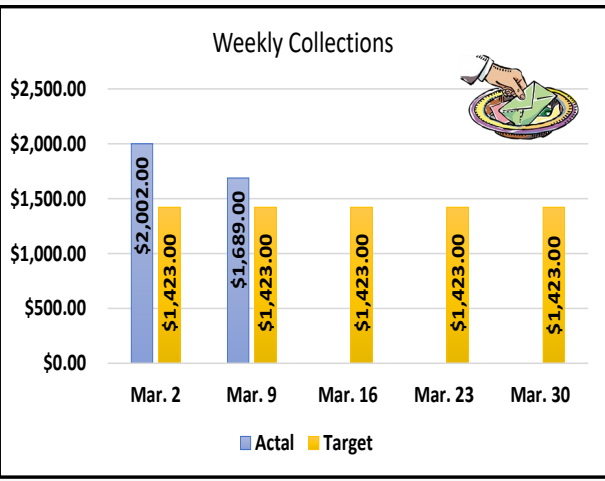
