Introduction: This Is Not a Waiting Room

Discernment isn't about waiting for a relationship. It's about walking closely with God, learning to listen to His voice, and living out your purpose today—with wisdom, love, and holy confidence.

You are not stuck. You are not behind. You are not forgotten. This is not a waiting room. It is a training ground for spiritual maturity and joy. Let's walk wisely, together.
