The Arm of the Lord - Study Resource

This companion study is designed for personal reflection, small group discussion, or journaling. It draws from the original blog post 'When I Thought It Said Arm - And Found Jesus Instead' and explores the powerful imagery of God's arm in Scripture.

Journaling Prompts

- 1. Think of a time when someone seemed 'too far gone' to be saved. What did you believe about God's power in that moment?
- 2. What is the difference between God's 'hand' and His 'arm' in Scripture? How do these metaphors help you understand His character?
- 3. Isaiah 59:16 says, 'His own arm brought salvation.' Reflect on what this means in light of the gospel and your personal walk with Christ.
- 4. How has God 'reached' into your own life in a way you didn't expect?
- 5. Write a prayer of thanks or petition using Isaiah 59:1 as your guide.
