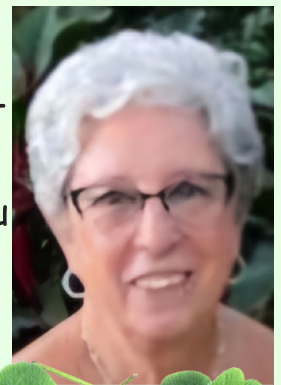

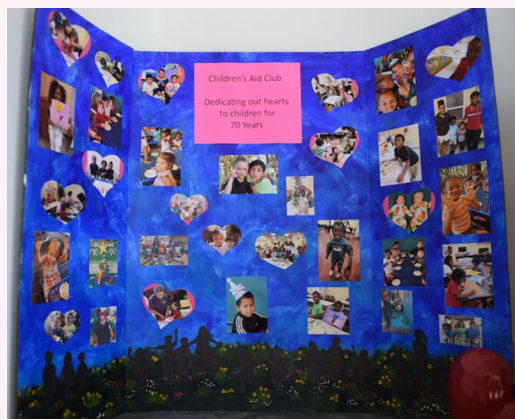


With Thanks

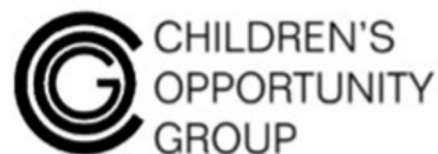
The following two charities will benefit from the proceeds of the tournament this year:
