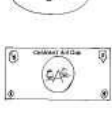

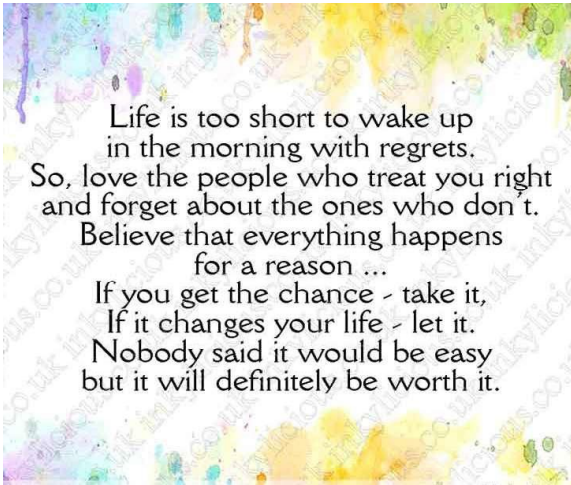

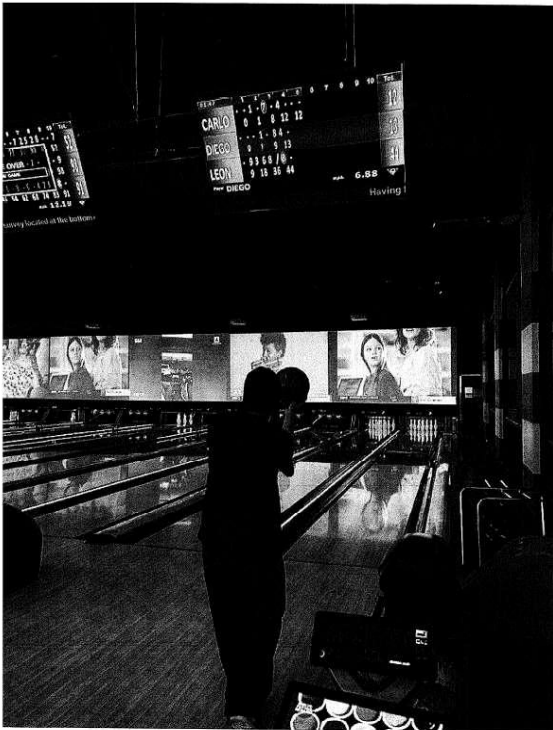

Have you ever noticed how a biography can read like an obituary? Pamela Markus born and raised in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, died while saving a puppy shortly after winning the Lottery. Her last words were, "I leave it all to Children's Aid Club," of course.



I am so proud to be a new member of CAC and to be following in my mom's footsteps. Her volunteerism inspires me to show up as a hard-worker, helpful volunteer and understanding friend to all who read this. I'm honored and grateful for the chance to share my little life's story with you in this edition.



My favorite part has always been school. Perhaps not grade school at St. Mark's Episcopal, and definitely not secondary at Ft. Lauderdale High; although my dual enrollment at Dillard Performing Arts was thoroughly entertaining. No, my favorite times were spent in drama school at Fort Lauderdale Children's Theatre during my formative years and all twelve years in Higher Education.



While I demonstrated some aptitude in performance, I was much more adept in teaching. My bossy nature was best put to use in the classroom. I cherished my students' learning, especially when I could bridge stage fright to confident performance.

I knew what I wanted to be as a teenager, and my degrees reflect it: B.A. in Theatre Education from Catawba College, N.C., M.Ed. in Theatre Pedagogy from Univer-



sity of North Carolina at Greensboro, and a Ph.D. in Education, specializing in Theatre from Virginia Commonwealth University, with a little stint at Ithaca University's London Program sometime before graduate school.



My teaching began right after undergrad at Bennett Elementary as a Resource teacher where I created an after-school Drama club touring to other local elementary schools. I am beyond pleased to be Bennett's liaison for CAC. Then, I became a one woman drama department at South Broward High School and established a Musical Theatre program until the principal asked me to teach Geography too.

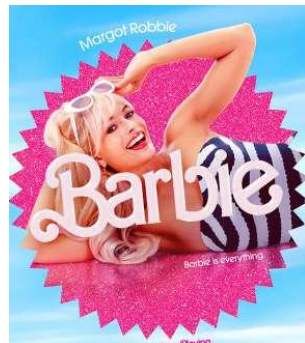
