Our Services

Licensed therapists provide speech, feeding, physical and occupational therapy to children with developmental delays, disabilities, or acquired injuries from birth to age 21.

PHYSICAL THERAPY

Physical therapists create personalized programs to enhance a child's movement, strength, balance, mobility, and motor skills. The treatment may involve therapeutic exercises and activities, functional training, physical agents, and/or assistive devices to help the child achieve maximum functional independence, alleviate pain, and avoid further impairments.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Occupational therapists specialize in helping children with a range of needs improve their cognitive, physical, sensory, and motor skills, which in turn helps to enhance their self-esteem, sense of accomplishment, and overall quality of life. Given that play and learning are a child's primary activities, occupational therapists often evaluate kids' skills for playing, school performance, and daily activities, and compare them with what is developmentally appropriate for their specific age group.

SPEECH THERAPY

Speech and language pathologists diagnose and evaluate speech problems that include fluency (stuttering), articulation, voice disorders, and language problems such as aphasia and delayed language. Therapists also treat feeding and swallowing difficulties.

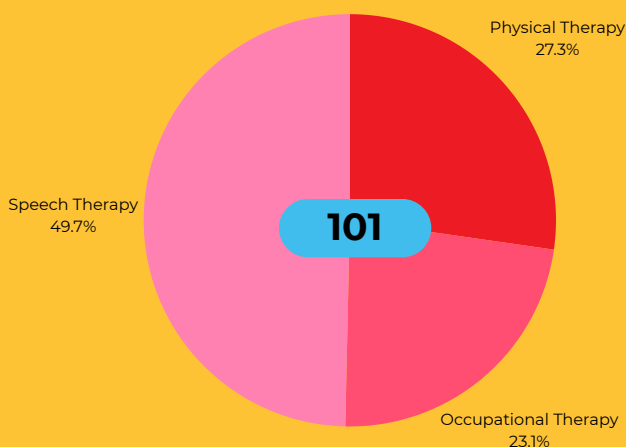

The Review In Year

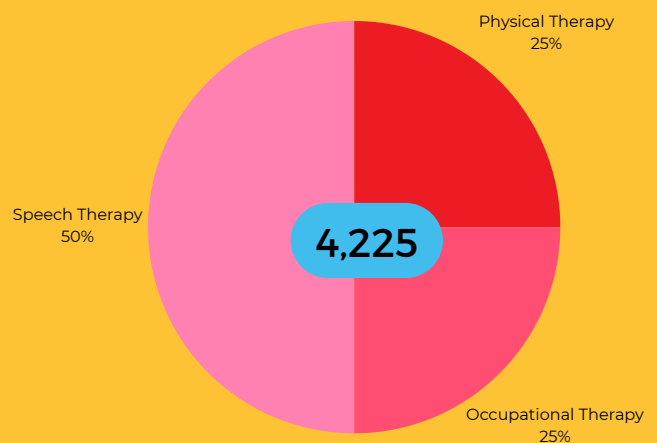
- Moody Clinic awarded the **first-two** patients the Charles' Legacy Patient Scholarship.
- Moody Clinic established the "Charles' Legacy Patient Scholarship Steering Committee" for advanced growth of the program.
- Moody Clinic was selected as the beneficiary of Ruby Barba's Fashion Show Fundraiser, a third-party fundraiser, with a gross financial outcome of \$50,075 and net financial outcome of \$37,614.94.
- Moody Clinic staff continued providing tours of the clinic to donors and community members with a financial outcome of \$90,270.
- Moody Clinic began meeting with legislators at the federal and state levels to establish relationships and express the needs of those we serve.
- Moody Clinic Staff received a second year of highly specialized training through a grant from the Valley Baptist Legacy Foundation.
