DO let the City of Saint Petersburg Police Department know about suspicious Activities or Persons in our neighborhood and when it is an emergency situation call 911. In Non-Emergency situations call 893-7780 or Text to TIP411 with SPPD at the beginning of the text message so it can be quickly directed to the Saint



Petersburg Police Department.

DO walk or jog facing traffic to see what the vehicles are doing as they approach you. You will not be surprised and you can move (out of the roadway) when they are being distracted. This is especially important since we do not have sidewalks in Riviera Bay.

DO consider installing Motion Activated LED lights on the front of your house (the motion area is within your yard) to reduce the interest by the night time Creepy Crawlers (thieves who try your car doors).

DO remove any valuables viewable from outside of your vehicles. If the valuables are of significant value the Creepy Crawlers will break your windows to retrieve it and anything else in your vehicles.

DO install cameras for recorded history of activities in front and possibly the back yards of your homes. Cameras themselves may not deter their activity but they can help law enforcement to arrest and prosecute the Creepy Crawlers.

DO join NextDoor, the National online blog for neighborhoods. It is a great place for sharing information and concerns. If you experience Creepy Crawlers you can notify the police and then notify your neighbors of the situation. If we are all working together on the Creepy Crawlers problem we can reduce it.

DO join the Riviera Bay Crime Watch! We assist the law enforcement

community in being Eyes and Ears in reporting suspicious activities in our community.

DO NOT forget to come to the next Riviera Bay Civic Association meeting on January 21st. At 6:30 PM we have free Pizza and Sodas. It is a great time to meet your neighbors. We will be holding our annual elections for the board of directors during this meeting.


