Chief Holloway and Assistant Chief Dente, along with other officers, updated the attendees with city statistics and programs. Overall, crime is down 25% in St. Petersburg. With our rapidly growing city, SPPD has plans to hire more officers and continue to reduce crime. We were informed of two new programs: PATH and HEAT. Police Assisting the Homeless is a new unit helping to assist the transient and homeless in our city who need and want help. And HEAT – Human Exploitation and Trafficking.

We broke out into mini sessions with each of the three districts sergeants and Officers. Sergeant Deary



and Officer Crawford did update more of our residents about the situation with transients at the WaWa on 4th Street. Our crime watch coordinator for Riviera Bay, Don Gilbert, and others worked with SPPD and WaWa Management to promptly solve the issue.

Ríviera Bay Butterfly Garden By Vicki Shuman

Butterfly Garden.

GAILLARDIA - BLANKET FLOWER. Also known as blanket flower, gaillardia is a sturdy native perennial with bright flowers that bloom throughout the summer and into the fall. The flowers grow on long stems above long, soft, hairy leaves. They are usually reddish purple or orange-red with yellow tips, but can also be solid yellow, orange, or red, and make excellent, long-lasting cut flowers that attract butterflies. Gaillardia re-seeds itself. Use gaillardia in the landscape as a ground cover, or plant it in containers. Gaillardia will tolerate extreme heat, sun, sandy soils, and even salt.

CLERODENDRUM UGANDENSE. Commonly known as Blue Butterfly Bush. this is a wonderful plant to have at home. It's not a fussy, high requirement plant. The flowers sport two hues of blue and truly resemble butterflies. The Blue Butterfly Bush requires warmth and light to flower. It flowers heavily during the warm months, and even if you cannot provide enough light

and warmth during the winter time it might sporadically flower anyway. In the winter I grow mine next to a west facing window with additional grow lights. It's a very easy to grow this plant, virtually pest free. The leaves have a bit If you like allamanda of a peppery smell to them, and that's probably the reason why this plant is quite resistant to bug infestations. It can survive down to 20°F, and sprout back from the root ball, but if grown indoors it's evergreen and with enough light everblooming.

PASSIFLORA INCARNATA. This is an herbaceous



vine, up to 25 ft. long, that climbs with axillary tendrils or sprawls along the ground. Intricate, 3 in., lavender flower are short-stalked from leaf axils. The petals and sepals subtend a fringe of wavy or crimped, hair-like segments. The pistil and stamens

Here are some snapshots of what is are also showy. Three-lobed, deciduous leaves are dark-planted in Riviera Bay's Community green above and whitish below. The fruit is a large, orangeyellow berry with edible pulp. Like some other passion vines, Maypop spreads by root suckers. The plants were given



the name Passionflower or Passion vine because the floral parts were once said to represent aspects of the Christian crucifixion story, sometimes referred to as the Passion. The name Maypop comes from the hollow. yellow fruits that pop loudly when crushed. Yellow Passion Flower (P. lutea), a small vellow-flowered

species, occurs from southeast Pennsylvania to Florida, west to Texas and Oklahoma, and north to Missouri, Illinois, and West Virginia.

ALLAMANDA SCHOTTII - YELLOW ALLAMANDA - Of all the allamanda varieties among South Florida shrubs, bush allamanda is probably the most easy-to-grow, with bright green foliage and abundant yellow flowers. The clusters of golden trumpet-shaped blossoms appear on and off most of the year - more during warmer weather. Its size and color make it an ideal accent, hedge or single


