At the last March General Membership meeting, the RBCA Board of Directors (BoD) requested approval to remove the Rose Garden at Riviera Bay Park and replace it with a butterfly garden. As you might know, Rose Gardens don't do too well in Florida and require an inordinate amount of maintenance.


On 15 April 2019, RBCA BoD members, Don Gilbert, Rich Perfidio, Vicki Shuman, and Dana and Patti Thomas, joined forces with the City of St. Petersburg and volunteers from Zephyrhills Water to plant a Butterfly Garden at the park. Though RBCA had approved funds for this project, Zephyrhills Water agreed to donate plants, drinking water and breakfast, if St. Petersburg and RBCA would provide some volunteer labor to work alongside their volunteers. Your RBCA BoD readily jumped in to help beautify our neighborhood.

This beautiful butterfly garden will attract various species and provide hours of colorful enjoyment. At the center of the garden is a butterfly/bird bath surrounded by two trellises. The trellises host Passion Flower vines and are surrounded by various herbs, butterfly bushes, milkweed, and other hummingbird and butterfly attractants. The design is both functional and aesthetically pleasing to provide color and food year-round.

We believe this partnership between RBCA, local government, and local business is a very big win for our community for generations to come.

n March 12, 2019, the Riviera Bay Crime Watch held a meeting at Liberty Baptist Church. We had 9 volunteers meet with Officer Cory Crawford and Sgt. Jason Deary of the St. Petersburg Police Department.

One of the items discussed was the procedure of calling into the non-emergency phone number of 727-893-7780. Our concerns were it takes so long to answer the report writer's questions of our identity it seems to be inhibiting quick response on the part of the police department. They indicated when we call in to say "Suspicious Activity or Person" then the report writer is typing the information in real time to the field officer who is dispatched to the location. This is taking place as we are reporting to the writer.

I have found the process is very quick when we call in and identify the reason for the call, then identify our self with name, address, and location.

The Crime Watch is always here for the odd situations: Trying to reduce the commercial net fisherman who plaque



our canals. If they are licensed, then they are allowed to net fish our canals, but they are not allowed by City Code to launch from our Sunlit Cove boat launch. The launch is for public use only. No commercial use is permitted.

The St. Petersburg Police Department reports that we are one of the lowest residential areas for Criminal Activity in the city. We all need to do our part in observing, reporting and protecting our property and our community.
