Community Service Office Crawford gave his report. Of some 180+ calls, almost half were initiated by the police. This is great and shows their proactive approach. Only one residential burglary of an adult tricycle was reported. Please remember to lock your cars and do not leave valuables in a vehicle. The Azalea Motel is now under nuisance abatement and being watched heavily by law enforcement. Please report any suspicious activity in and around this area.

A Riviera Bay resident, Dr Brian Leeson, presented his brand new dental practice, 4th Street Family Dentistry, which he opened at 1808 4th Street North (Phone 727-270-9080). He promoted his practice's use of more eco-friendly products and a minimal usage of single use plastics. His office offers discount plans if you do not have dental insurance coverage. Dr. Leeson mentioned his businesses partnership with Tampa Bay Watch and how he and his staff participate in local clean up efforts. We hope to see Dr. Leeson and his staff at RBCA's Canal Clean Up in the spring.

Nancy McKibben from Commissioner Justice's office presented updates on the San Martin Bridge. Construction is projected for 2025-27 and estimated to cost \$13 million. The new bridge will have a 19' vertical clearance, a 50' wide horizontal clearance and have a 75 year life expectancy. It is an extension of the Pinellas Trail and closes the south loop gap. 
