These claims are obviously created when the member is marked off for the Federal Requirement, and should be claimed for the class of service they are working in. Extra board engineers should claim the loss of their guarantee, regular assignments should claim the amount they would have made on the assignment that day, and rotating pool engineers should claim the earnings of what they lost, if possible to determine, or basic days if not.

This is another scenario where board snapshots and work histories would benefit in showing what the member would have stood for.

The appeal would look as follows:

"Claim is submitted without prejudice to the Organization's position that the violation constitutes a major dispute under the Railway Labor Act. The Claimant was assigned to the (Job ID); this board is bulletined to work on call, without rest days. The Claimant had six consecutive starts causing him to be placed into Federally Required rest. Per the hours of service as amended, the Claimant could not perform service during this time. As a result, the Claimant lost work opportunities on (dates) OR was penalized (amount) off of his Engineers extra board guarantee. (If applicable) Please allow the Claimant one basic day at the applicable rate for each of his lost work opportunities."
