TRAINING SERVICES PROVIDED

STTP Kennels will provide professional bird hunting training, including:

- Obedience work, gun exposure, bird introduction, and field work.
- Use of live birds (additional cost, see below).
- Proper care, housing, and handling of your dog.

Bird usage varies by dog, training goals, and progression. Most dogs average 3–5 birds per training day. Estimated bird costs range between \$350–\$500 per week depending on bird type and availability.

Non-refundable and based on the estimated total of training, boarding, and bird costs.

Balance Due: \$ _____

Due within 3 days of training completion and before release of dog. Any unpaid balance after 3 days may incur a 10% late fee.

Clients arriving more than 30 minutes late for scheduled drop-off, pick-up, or training appointments without prior communication may be subject to a \$100 fee.

If additional training sessions are needed following completion of the board and train program, sessions will be billed at \$125 per hour plus the cost of birds used. Sunday training sessions are complimentary, with clients responsible only for bird costs.

If the trainer must cancel due to unforeseen circumstances, the deposit will be refunded or applied to a rescheduled date.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

- Client must provide proof of current Rabies, Distemper/Parvo & Bordetella vaccinations 7 days before drop-off.
- Client must communicate any health, behavioral, or dietary needs prior to training.
- Client is responsible for any veterinary care, medications, and related costs.
- Client is responsible for providing the dog’s food unless otherwise agreed upon.
- Female dogs in heat must be disclosed prior to arrival. STTP Kennels reserves the right to reschedule or refuse training for females in heat.

VETERINARY EMERGENCY AUTHORIZATION

In the event of illness, injury, or emergency, STTP Kennels is authorized to seek veterinary treatment for the dog at the owner’s expense if the owner cannot be reached promptly.

CLIENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Drop-off and pick-up must be at scheduled times. Dogs left beyond scheduled pick-up will incur an additional \$100/day boarding fee.
- If the client cancels training after booking, the deposit is forfeited.
- Client agrees to disclose any history of aggression, biting, anxiety, or dangerous behavior prior to training. STTP Kennels reserves the right to refuse or discontinue training for dogs displaying unsafe behavior.

LIABILITY & INDEMNIFICATION

- Client acknowledges training and boarding involve inherent risks, including injury, illness, or loss.
- Client accepts full responsibility for these risks and agrees to release, indemnify, and hold harmless STTP Kennels, its owner(s), and agents from all claims, costs, or damages, except in cases of proven gross negligence or willful misconduct.
- Client grants permission for STTP Kennels to photograph and/or video the dog for training, promotional, and social media purposes.
- Client acknowledges and authorizes the use of approved electronic training collars as part of the training process when deemed appropriate by the trainer.
- Client understands that all dogs learn differently and that no specific training outcome, level of performance, or timeline can be guaranteed.
