  - Cub Scout Shirt
    - Blue T-Shirt for Lions
    - Blue Cub Scout Button down shirt for Tiger/Wolf/Bear Scouts
    - Beige Boy Scout Button Down Shirt for Webelos/Arrow of Light
  - Pack 1151 patch
  - National Capital Area patch
  - Fleur De Lis patch
  - Cap for current Den
  - Note: The complete uniform will cost approximately \$45
- What not to buy
  - Belt (optional)
  - Uniform pants/skorts (optional – most boys just wear shorts or pants)
  - Slide (Den leader will give you this)
  - Neckerchief (Den leader will give you this)
  - Den book (Den leader will give you this, tells you where to sew the patches)
