



Welcome to year 3 of the Boys & Girls Club of Lake Shore Morning & Afternoon Junior's Program

These two programs are New York State registered where membership is available to students living and enrolled within the Lake Shore Central School District, however space is limited. Registration is on a first come first serve basis.

About:

All of our programs offer a nurturing environment designed to meet their physical, intellectual, social and emotional needs. The Club also offers a quality After-School Program at the W.T Hoag Educational Center, located at 42 Sunset Blvd in Angola serving kids 1st - 8th Grade.

Program Highlights:

Crafts, Gym Time, Healthy Snacks, Puzzles, Board Games, STEAM, Legos AND MORE!

General Information:

Morning Program starts at 6:30 am and ends at 8:30 am for Pre-K and at bus pick up time for grades K-8. You may bring in a snack for your child to eat, if breakfast is needed, they will be able to obtain breakfast from the district when they arrive at their school.

Afternoon Junior's Program starts at 2:30pm for Pre-K or bus arrival for grade K until 6pm. We provide a daily healthy snack.

Both programs are open according to the official school calendar of the Lake Shore Central School District and are closed during inclement weather days. The After School Junior's Program will remain OPEN when after school activities are canceled due to weather.

Pricing:

At the time of enrollment, a non-refundable fee is required. The first month's tuition will be billed in August. The 2026-27 enrollment fee is \$30 per child or \$50 per family. Monthly fee is based on how many days a child attends per week and is due the 1st of the month. **Erie County Subsidized care is currently on a waitlist - packet available upon request.**

Medical:

If your child has ANY doctor diagnosed allergies, special need, medical condition and/or has a need for an EpiPen or Inhaler while in the program, then additional paperwork is required to be completed by a doctor. An Individual Healthcare Plan will need to be submitted and approved prior to the start of the program. Forms will be provided

Transportation:

Students in grades K and up will need to be transported to and/or from their schools via Lake Shore Central School District transportation. Families of those students will need to submit a transportation request form to the Lake Shore Central School Transportation Department Bus Garage.

Registration Process:

Your registration request is not complete until ALL of the steps in the Registration Process have been completed, and the enrollment fee is paid

1. Complete the 2026-27 School Year Child Care **Application**. ALL areas must be filled out. Fill out 1 per child
2. Complete the program **enrollment** form(s) Fill out 1 per child, per program
3. Review/sign Boys & Girls Club of Lake Shore 26/27 School Year Tuition Agreement.
4. Review the Boys & Girls Club of Lake Shore 26/27 SACC Family Handbook
5. Sign and return acknowledgement page of the Family Handbook
6. Submit all documentation, via the following methods:

7. Remit the non-refundable enrollment fee of \$30 per child or \$50 per family.
