CLUB MEMBER ORIENTATION:

Lake Shore Clubhouse - Please do not pull into the circle before 4pm, as that is where the busses pull into the circle- park in a parking spot and ring the bell.

After 4pm, pull along the circle and come to the door to ring the bell.

VALUABLES & ELECTRONICS :

The Club is NOT liable for any items lost or stolen at the Club. It is recommended that members do not bring valuables to the Club; you will NOT be able to lock up your valuable items you bring. They will be your responsibility. Any items left at the end of the day will be placed in the Lost and Found bin.

SNACK SHACK :

Our Snack Shack is open once a day at 4pm. We have snacks, drinks, and hot food available. All of our snacks cost \$3.00 and under.

MEMBER BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT

Commitment: All staff at The Boys & Girls Club of Lake Shore offers Club members the opportunity for positive social-emotional development through a variety of structured programs. These programs are based on five core groups: The Arts (arts & crafts, drawing/coloring contests, photography and writing); Education (computer lab, Project Learn, Power Hour); Civic Engagement (Junior Staff and Torch Club); Life Skills (SMART Moves, Girls Club, Healthy Habits); and Sports, Fitness and Recreation (flag football, floor hockey, dodgeball, Triple Play, gamesroom). Our staff recognizes the individual nature of each child, and endeavors to provide a sense of belonging and an overall feeling of safety, for all of our members. Infractions such as swearing directed at staff and/ or another member, drug use/possession, stealing, disrespect towards staff and/or other members, member intimidation, and bullying will not be tolerated and will result in suspension up to member termination.
