FFK Journey Information for 2022 & 2023



Australia, Outbound Journey # 22408 (October 19- November 2, 2022): There are 11 Ambassadors eagerly awaiting the start of this Journey that includes an optional stay in Sydney, and 2 weeks visiting the Friendship Force Clubs of the Gold Coast and North Moreton. Both of these hosts clubs are in Queensland.

Open World Uzbekistan Judges October 7-15, 2022: We will host five Uzbek judicial delegates, a facilitator and an interpreter through the Open World Congressional program to allow them to learn about the United States judicial system and also to share information with local judges and lawyers about their system. The agenda will not be finalized until after we learn the backgrounds of the delegate judges, but it will include observing Federal and State court proceedings, meeting with judges, visiting both LMU and UT law schools, and meeting with other local officials and lawyers.



Betsy Tonkin is the FFK coordinator for the visit, with Marsha Mitchell and Courtney Shea co-coordinating. U.S. District Judge Thomas Varlan will be the Host Judge. If you are willing to host one of these delegates in your home or host a dinner, please contact Betsy ASAP. We will need to provide host names and information by Sept. 7. (betst@mac.com)
