

Onward to this month. No program, but we're getting together for lunch on Aug. 22 at Calhoun's on the River. I hope to see you there!



# October Member Recruiting Meeting! Save the Date!





# FFK Journey to Tuxtla-Gutierrez



The preparation for the FFK Journey to Tuxtla-Gutierrez is underway with five FFK members traveling. FF Tuxtla-Gutierrez has also invited a Friendship Force club from Germany for the same week so it will truly be an international experience! This journey is in two parts with the core activities taking place November 1-7, 2023, and a post-journey option from November 8-10, 2023.

Activities for the journey include Day of the Dead celebrations on November 2, 2023, trips to Chiapa de Corzo and San Cristobal, museums, a National Park, native villages, a botanic garden and a zoo. The post tour option is for two nights at the Chan-kah Resort Village hotel to visit the Mayan ruins in Palenque.
