Participating in either inbound or outbound journeys is the pathway that the founders of Friendship Force created. Our club has many journey opportunities for you to participate in and a few of the ways you can help are listed below:



- The Host Coordinator has the responsibility to organize the itinerary and events for incoming ٠ ambassadors to enjoy. You can also help plan a part of the itinerary.
- The Ambassador Coordinator has the responsibility to organize FFK members who wish to participate in an outbound journey to another club.
- A Home Host opens their home to incoming ambassadors from another club and coordinates their ٠ attendance in the various activities our club has planned for the visitors. The Home Host is responsible for providing a bed & bathroom, breakfast, and, perhaps, other meals depending on the itinerary for the visit.
- A Day Host helps the FFK Home Host by providing transportation for a day to one of the activities, ٠ giving the Home Host a rest for the day. You get to know our visitors that you are transporting as well as participate in the event for the day.
- Hosting a Small Group Dinner also helps the Home Host by breaking up the cooking duties and ٠ introducing the visitors to more members of our club. You can host a dinner on your own or share the job with another membe.
