### **International Exchange Preview**

We have been asked by Friendship Force International to participate in an incoming journey from Cape of Good Hope, South Africa to Western North Carolina and Knoxville, U.S.A. We will keep you informed as this develops.

### **OUTBOUND JOURNEYS**

#### La Serena, Chile

FFK will be going to La Serena, Chile in November 2018 in a joint exchange with the Friendship Force Club, Raleigh. The total cost of the La Serena journey, tentatively November 1-13, is estimated to be in the range of \$3000 to \$3500 per person, which includes airfare, pre trip cost of 5 nights and daily activities in Santiago, activities and expenses in La Serena, insurance, Friendship Force fees, and incidentals. The committee is also giving strong consideration to a pre-extension stop at nearby Santiago but consideration will be given to other alternate pre- or post-journey trips to Easter Island, the Andes, the Atacama Desert, or Patagonia in the final planning stage. These trips could add \$1000 to \$4000.
