Known for its premier Colorado wineries, this quaint town nestled in the Grand Valley houses two-thirds of Colorado's vineyard acreage and more than one-quarter of Colorado wineries. Sitting atop artesian wells, which provide irrigation for the grape growers, the Grand Valley's microclimate of sunny days, dry air and cool nights work together to produce plump grapes for the area wineries. The result? Award-winning wines.
