To help you understand the proposed changes to the governing documents, each section of the documents includes a brief explanation in bold at the top. We know this is a lot of information and a significant update—reflecting just how outdated our current documents are—so please don't hesitate to reach out if you have any questions. In addition, we will be voting on a \$200 Special Assessment Fee to help fund critical and necessary maintenance projects within our community.
