1. Battle of Gettysburg (July 1 - 3, 1863) One of the most critical battles of the **American Civil War**, the **Battle of Gettysburg** saw the **Union Army** defeat the **Confederate** forces. This battle marked a turning point in the war, leading to the eventual defeat of the **Confederacy**.

2. The Independence Day (July 4, 1776) On this day, the **Continental Congress** adopted the **Declaration of Independence**, announcing the thirteen **American colonies** as independent states, free from **British**

3. The Korean War Armistice (July 27, 1953) The Korean War Armistice Agreement was signed on this day, ending hostilities between **North** and **South Korea**. The agreement established the **Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ)**, a buffer zone between the two nations.

4. The Apollo 11 Moon Landing (July 20, 1969) While not a military event, this significant achievement showcased American ingenuity and determination. **Neil Armstrong** and **Buzz Aldrin** became the first humans to set foot on the moon, marking a significant milestone in the **Space Race** during the **Cold War**.

5. Operation Husky (July 9 - August 17, 1943) The **Allied** invasion of **Sicily**, codenamed **Operation Husky**, began on July 9, 1943. This major campaign during **World War II** led to the fall of the Fascist regime in **Italy** and opened up the **Mediterranean Sea** lanes for the **Allies**.

6. The Battle of Tinian (July 24 - August 1, 1944) Part of the **Pacific** campaign of **World War II**, the **Battle of Tinian** saw U.S. forces capturing the island from the Japanese. The island later served as a base for B-29 bombers, including those that carried out the atomic bombings of **Hiroshima** and **Nagasaki**.

These historical events remind us of the bravery, sacrifice, and strategic prowess of our military forces. As we gather to celebrate **Independence Day**, let's also reflect on the significant contributions and sacrifices made by our servicemen and women throughout history.

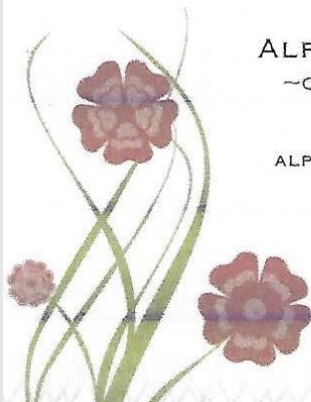

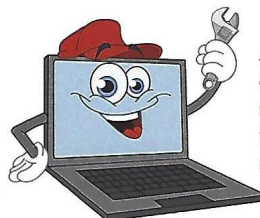


