Grass Roots Muddy Boots Forest School makes every effort to ensure that you and your child stay safe during our sessions. Careful risk assessment and training has been carried out. However, it is important to understand that part of the Forest School ethos is concerned with allowing children to take a degree of risk in order to be able to start assessing risk for themselves.

During the sessions there may be access to a range of tools for children to use in order to develop skills in whittling, carving, sawing etc and whilst careful assessment of the individual's skill and ability will be made there will still be a measured risk of injury which individuals take a personal responsibility for.

This is also the case for fire lighting. Children and adults will be taught according to our policies and procedures,

You are required to disclose any special or specific needs your child may have. This is to be recorded on the booking form and includes; behaviour issues, physical disability, special educational needs, allergies, dietary requirements, medical issues. We need this information so that we can plan sessions accordingly and keep all children safe.
