

## FOOD HANDLING

- We will provide hand washing facilities, to enable children to wash and dry their hands.
- Children are asked to wash their hands before they eat food and after they have used the toilet
- Hand sanitiser is provided in addition to this but is not to be used as substitute.
- No trace is left.
- Children are expected to bring a drink of water to Forest School in a named bottle
- We carry a supply of water for hand washing but this is not to be used as drinking water to avoid cross contamination
- Children bring their own packed lunches to holiday club.
- Children are allowed to eat their lunch where they choose and are reminded to eat their food out of their packed lunch boxes.
- Food prepared on the fire must be done or supervised by an adult that has completed an approved by GRMB food handling course at level 2.
- Food should be prepared, stored and cooked within the latest guidelines of an approved outdoor food handling course.
  Level 2 training
- Children are encouraged to bring eco conscious food packaging solutions and are asked to take all their litter home. This is so parents can see what children have eaten and also so children take responsibility for they own waste.
