

Teacher Spotlight: Gregg Standridge, head of guitar department



Gregg Standridge began playing drums when he was 14 and switched to mandolin after hearing the album "Every Picture Tells a Story" by Rod Stewart. He then picked up guitar with help from his friend Paul Hendrix. Hendrix showed him the basic chords and how to figure out songs by ear. He also began to play in old line country bands and rock bands in South Oklahoma City.

He then earned the opportunity to study music at OCCC and USAO. He finished his Masters Degree in classical guitar at Oklahoma City University. After living in Los Angeles for one year Standridge moved back to the greater OKC area and then began writing and performing with the Norman based bands "Inspector 12" and "Doc and the Delivery Boys." After these 2 projects he began building his teaching studio which he still maintains today through the Norman Music Institute in Norman, OK. Standridge currently performs solo and duo shows in the OKC area and with The Sunday Flyers, Terry Buffalo Ware and The Shambles, The Empty Bottles and The Rumfellows. Gregg is also half of the duo Big Dumb Buildings which wrote and produced the full length musical Spots & Stripes which debuted last year in Norman Ok.
