What is the world's view of sexual pleasure?

(Taken from John MacArthur - NT Commentary)

- 1. The world believes that man is basically good so ANY desire for sexual pleasure must be good for man.
- 2. Since sexual activity is biological in nature it can't be viewed in a moral framework.
- 3. Since casual sex is a form of pleasure and has no moral framework it is okay to treat it as simply another form of recreation.

What is the world's view of sexual pleasure?

- 4. Fulfillment of one's sexual goals is a major purpose in the life of a non-believer.
- 5. Instant gratification is a god worshiped by the world, more than building relationships. (Epicureanism)
- 6. Since sexual activity is so important to marriage the world thinks pre-martial sexual activity is imperative before they commit to marriage. How does pornography help/hurt?

For you know what instructions we gave you through the Lord Jesus. 

- 1. Religions in Ephesus (and Corinth and Thessalonica) promoted sexual permissiveness. (See Acts 19-20)
- 2. Their religions advocated for sexual prostitution.
- 3. They taught religious followers to engage in temple prostitution and sexual pleasure.

What was life like in the day of Paul's instructions?


- 4. The Temple of Aphrodite in Corinth employed as many as 1,000 priestesses who were religious prostitutes.
- 5. People did not consider fornication and adultery illegal or immoral. They publicly condoned it.
- 6. It would be rare to find a convert in the Thessalonian church who had NOT lived in this permissive manner.

Is pornography a victimless crime?

Does it wrong anyone?

Frame your mindset to not hurt anyone by impurity:

- 1. Impurity in your life hurts others in their life.
 - that no one transgress and wrong his brother in this matter (wrong - to be covetous)
- 2. Impurity puts the wheels of God's vengeance in motion.
 - · because the Lord is an avenger in all these things
- 3. Impurity is governed by God's already stated instructions.
 - as we told you beforehand and solemnly warned you

Frame your mindset to not hurt anyone by impurity:

1 Corinthians 6:18 (ESV)

Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own

1 Corinthians 7:5 (ESV)

Do not deprive one another, except perhaps by agreement for a limited time, that you may devote yourselves to prayer; but then come together again, so that Satan may not tempt you because of your lack of self-control.

Frame your mindset to not hurt anyone by impurity:

Hebrews 13:4 (ESV)

Let marriage be held in honor among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled, for God will judge the sexually immoral and adulterous.




- 1. Walking in the Spirit stops us from gratifying the desires of the flesh.


