You will have noticed since the church opened for Holy Week some changes. There is now a dividing wall in the church and new paint and carpet in the Sanctuary. This is to make the chapel a place of worship and social interaction. The chapel house too needed some repairs to the roof as water was coming in necessitating plaster and paint work. And so, the list goes on!
The diocese has very generously funded some of this work, thanks in a large part to Mgr Hugh Bradley the dioecian Administrator. The drive up to the church house also needs to be repaired. This will cost £7,500 (exc VAT). The diocese will contribute £5,000 therefore we will need to raise £2,500.... How? I have paid the insurance recently which was £6,000 so fuds are low. 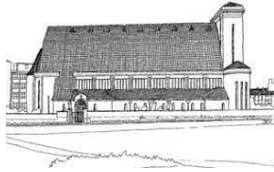
