### A Thought of the day – St. Peter Julian Eymard

**3<sup>rd</sup> July** (Saint Thomas) According to Jesus Christ himself, our faith will make us happier than that of the Apostles, St. Thomas: Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed. And why? Because there is more of a surrender to believe without having seen a proof of faith, then to surrender and to adore as a result of a miracle.

**4<sup>th</sup> July** Always be prepared to say to God: My heart is ready, oh my God, to accomplish your holy Will in everything. But this vigilance must be free, without bondage, without stress. It is the vigil of love, and love doesn't tire. It watches while it sleeps, it watches while it works.

**5<sup>th</sup> July** The wind of the holy will of God is always beneficial for the sails of our little ship. We only need to keep the sails open and firm, and to look at Jesus who precedes us.

**6<sup>th</sup> July** We cannot always have happy feelings, but always be happy when our will is united to God's.

**7<sup>th</sup> July** You must have eyes, ears, taste and hopes only for the holy Will of God at each moment. Hold our Lord's hand and tell him: "Lead me where you will".

**8<sup>th</sup> July** We are well wherever divine love places us, but we need to be there as God wills.

**9<sup>th</sup> July** The proof that God is the center of a soul is when God's truth is her joy, when the will of God is her happiness, when God's love is her inspiration, the great engine, and the great virtue of her life.

### Invitation to the Nigerian Catholic Community harvest & Bazaar

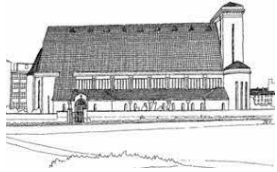
