Introduction to the Mass: At every Mass, we hear Jesus' words 'This is the new covenant in my blood.' Today, we hear how Joshua invited the people of Israel to renew the covenant God had made with their ancestor at Sinai. In the Gospel, Jesus offers his disciples the freedom to go their own way or to remain with him. The same choice is offered to us today. Let us accept, with faith and love, the opportunity to follow the Lord.

First Reading (Josh 24:1-2.15-18) When they have settled in the land God promised to give them, Joshua gathers the people and invites them to follow his example and to remain faithful to the covenant with the God who rescued them from slavery.

Second Reading (Eph 5:21-32) Christians look to Christ as the model to follow in their relations with others. Wives and husband especially will find in him a model for unselfish love.

Gospel (Jn 6:60-69) Many of those who heard Jesus speaking about the Bread of Life turn away, Jesus gives those who remain a stark choice: to go or to stay with him. Peter answers for them and for us: 'Lord, to whom can we go? You have the message of eternal life.'
