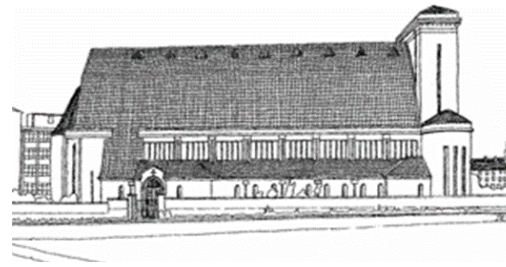


## PRAYER FOR ST COLUMBA'S PARISH

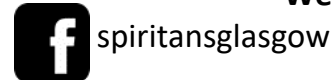

## READINGS

FIRST READING—AMOS 8:4-7

### RESPONSORIAL PSALM: 112

### **SECOND READING—1 TIMOTHY 2:1-8**

My advice is that, first of all, there should be prayers offered for everyone—petitions, intercessions and thanksgiving—and especially for kings and others in authority, so that we may be able to live religious and reverent lives in peace and quiet. To do this is right, and will please God our saviour; He wants everyone to be saved and reach full knowledge of the truth. For there is only one God, and there is only one mediator between God and mankind, himself a man, Christ Jesus, who sacrificed himself as a ransom for them all. He is the evidence of this, sent at the appointed time, and I have been named a herald and apostle of it and—I am telling the truth and no lie—a teacher of the faith and truth to the pagans.

In every place, then, I want the men to lift their hands up reverently in prayer, with no anger or argument.
