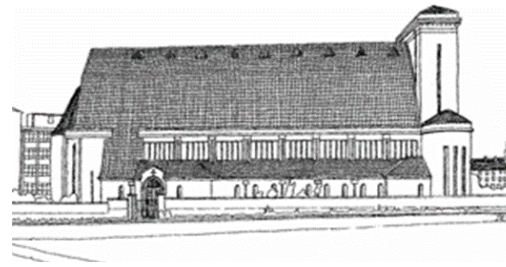


PRAYER FOR ST COLUMBA'S PARISH

OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY OF MANAOAG

Next Sunday, the 6th of October, after our 11am Mass here, we shall join the Filipino Community in the Community Central Halls as they mark this special feast which always occur on the first Sunday of October—the Sunday nearest the 7th of October. Pope Pius XI granted a Canonical Coronation to the image on 22 April 1926, while Pope Benedict XVI raised her sanctuary in equal indulgences to the Basilica of Saint Mary Major on 21 June 2011. Under this Marian title, the Blessed Virgin Mary is invoked as patroness of the sick, helpless and needy.
